RHEMA CSP & CDSP

CSP Curriculum Meeting

We conducted the CSP curriculum meetings on the following dates of this month in that we shared about the following topics to the mothers through the various methods.

20th May 2017 – How to earn money through micro entrepreneurs skill – 12 mothers participated

27th May 2017 – First Aid through available materials – 13 mothers were participated

Home Prayer:

On May 2017, we conducted the 20 Home Prayers in Different areas. In this home prayer the topic was based on the Bible verse Genesis 32:28 “And he said, Thy name shall be called no more Jacob, but Israel: for as a prince hast thou power with God and with men, and hast prevailed”. We prayed for the requested prayer points by the mothers who were participated. Totally 11 CSP mothers, 67 CDSP mothers and 13 others were participated.

RHEMA Academy

We conducted the Competitive exam coaching classes on daily basis and weekend classes also. This classes going very well. Our senior children are also included in the daily classes. It was a very useful for their future Govt. Job exams. Through this coaching classes 11 students and 3 staff were attended the Staff Selection Exam (Multi Task), Tamil Nadu Uniform Reserve Police Service Exam and Postal Exam.

Public Exam Results

In 12th Standard Public Exam attended by 14 children, in that 13 Children passed in this exam. Mas. Sudalai Muthu got 995 marks, is a first mark in our project. 3 children got above 900marks and 5 children got above 800 marks.

In 10th Standard Public Exam attended by 14 children, all the children were participated in this exam. Our child Priya got 458 marks, is a first mark in our Project. 5 Children got above 400 marks.

Links Peace - MED

Programme is functioning well with 163 beneficiaries being provided with Fund assistance to start viable ventures. The repayment of the beneficiaries is very encouraging making us to give advance to more beneficiaries. At present there are 39beneficiaries encouraging with MED loan.

MEDICAL CAMP

Every effort is taken to enhance the life style of the remote Rural Dweller. Medical Camps are held where there are no medical facilities; quality Medical attention is offered at the Medical Camps.

Education:

During the month of May 2017, all the Children have left the home for Annual vacation, on 30.4.2017. The children were advised not to go out in the day time in the hot sun. The parents were very happy to take them to home. I have visited the nearby villages of Kalakadu and Naguneri to fill up the vacancies of the home for this academic Year 2017 - 2018. All the students who appeared for SSLC and HSC Examinations, got good marks.

Administration:

The Registration Certificate for our home is renewed by the Tamil Nadu Government for further period of 5 years.

TANSACS CORE GROUP PROJECT

The APAC - VHS - USAID sponsored STI, HIV/ AIDS Prevention project among Core Groups has completed three years of Yeomen service to the targeted community of Female Sex Workers and Men Having Sex with Men. Now the project had transitioned to the TANSACS for the next 1 year. (April'17 to March'18) Activities.

Followings are the activities implemented in the month of April '17

* Individual HRGs interactions with MSM were 681 and FSW were 687.

*13 Group meetings were conducted to FSW and 62 participated.

*9 Group meetings were conducted to MSM and 50 participated.

*Number of HRG's tested in the STI Clinics MSM - 205 , FSW - 193 and PT- 3 (Total : 401)

*Number of ICTC Referral and tested for FSW - 114 and MSM - 98 (Total : 212)

*3 DIC level meetings were conducted and 85 HRG's participated

*9 Hotspot level meetings were conducted. (73 HRG's participated)

*Our ongoing HRG is FSW : 687 and MSM : 681 (Total :1366)

Important Points:

◆ TG Clinic inaugurated on 30.05.17 to free legal service for TGs in Multi Purpose Centre, Peace Trust by Judge and Advocate. On the spot 2 TGs and 1 FSW gave complaint to the Judge. Advocates will visit to clinic in weekly twice.

◆ Known your HRG details completed.

In this month PE & Staff Review meetings conducted by our Assistant Director Mr.Vijay Barnabass and gave many suggestions key important points for develop of our Core group project



TANSACS TI-MIGRANT PROJECT

- ⇒ Identified 775 Migrants as HRG
- ⇒ Provided One to One to 848 Migrants (New)
- ⇒ Provided One to One to 488 Migrants (Follow up)
- ⇒ 154 Group sessions conducted among migrants and 1988 migrants participated in the group.
- ⇒ 237 migrants tested in the ICTC Camp
- ⇒ Counseling services given to 336 migrants
- ⇒ 4 Staff review meeting conducted in our Project office

- ⇒ 2 Games Program conducted in Kalakad and Koodankulam
- ⇒ 9 ICTC Camps conducted in Koodankulam 3 (159), Kavalkinaru (92) Kalakad (45) Prancheri (47) Tirunelveli (38) and Chettikulam (52) and 433 migrants participated in Health camp.
- ⇒ 2 Advocacy meeting conducted in Chettikulam and Koodankulam.
- ⇒ 2 Demand Generaion meeting conducted in Kavalkinaru and Chettikulam.

CARE AND SUPPORT PROJECT

- ⇒ 15 Support Groups were conducted. Out of 201 members, 146 members participated in the meeting.
- ⇒ 3 Block co-ordination meetings were conducted. Out of 39 members, 34 members participated.
- ⇒ Seven friends' forum programs were conducted and 47 members participated.
- ⇒ The LSE - 4 programs were conducted, 86 children participated.
- ⇒ 13 Adolescent clubs functioning well. Among the 290 members 264 of them participated in the last month meeting.

Soft skill training to the Adolescents :

Two soft skill training programs were conducted for male and female during the last month, respectively. 10 male and 7 female participated in this program. Embroidering, handy work making, paper flower making, works in hospital, sales women were the skills given by the specialist resource persons for the girls. Book binding, plumbing, electrician, palm product making were the major skills given to the male participants.

Adolescent Mela:

The adolescent mela was organized on 25 - 05 - 2017 at Deaf school, Palayamkottai. Around 140 adolescent from Peace Trust participated in this program. District judge, Mr. Rajasekaran and Mr. Ramalingam were participated as the special guests in this program. They delivered the adolescent right based messages to the participants.



Nellai Sutram AGBM:

On 27th May 2017, the Nellai sutram AGBM was organized at Vanavil Kalyanamandabam, Tirunelveli. From the five working blocks 84 Nellaisuram members participated in this program .
