CSP Curriculum Meeting

On 9th September 2017, we conducted the CSP curriculum meeting to share about the medicinal uses on Universal Medicine Week (4th Sep – 11th Sep).

Home Prayer

We conducted 10 Home Prayers in different areas and discussed based on the Bible verse Daniel 4:27. We shared the Miracles done by Jesus from the Bible portions John 9:1-41, Mathew 9:20-22, Luke 17:11-19, Mark 2:1-12 & 7:31-37. Totally 4 CSP mothers, 41 CDSP mothers and 5 others participated.

Child in Prayer

We organized the Child in Prayer meeting for our children on 2nd September 2017. We taught the songs about "Devanin Azhayam" the meaning of the song is "Temple of God" and shared a story based on the memory verse 1 Corinthians 3:9,16. Children prayed to the prayer requests given to them. Totally 98 children participated in the meeting.

- ◇ On 23rd of this month, we taught about "Obedience". We shared the story and drama among the children, 116 children participated in the meeting.

- We organized the Special day during the Quarterly Holidays for our Children from 25th to 27th September 2017.
- On 25th – Sports Day – All the Individual events and indoor game conducted to our Children
- On 26th – Health Day – The short films about the Cleanliness of our Body were shown
- On 27th – Career Day – How to develop our Personality to follow the SMART (Specific, Measurable, Applicable, Realist & Time)

Links Peace - MED

Programme is functioning well with 168 beneficiaries being provided with Fund assistance to start viable ventures. The repayment of the beneficiaries is very encouraging making us to give advance to more beneficiaries. At present there are 37 beneficiaries encouraging with MED loan.

Every effort is taken to enhance the life style of the remote Rural Dweller. Medical Camps are held where there are no medical facilities; quality Medical attention is offered at the Medical Camps.

EDUCATION

As some of the new students were not able to pick up and slow in their studies, the respective teachers and the warden were instructed to take care of the children till their examination is over.

English Grammar class

As usual, Mr. Chandran, an English tutor handles the English Grammar class from 6.00 pm to 7.30 pm every Tuesday and Saturday for 8th STD to 11th STD students.

Computer Class: -

The computer teacher completed the basic computer topics like micro soft word, Microsoft excel, internet access, mail id creation etc.. till date. During the month of September, power point presentations were taught to them.

Health Aspects

The Child protection unit instructed us to keep the home neat and clean to prevent from water borne diseases as it is rainy season. Already our home follows the preventive measures in all aspects. So we ensure and gave assurance to District Child protection unit. We provide aqua water daily for all Children.

Vocational Field Trip

After the quarterly examination, we took the children to Trivandrum for educational field trip. 31 children and six staff participated in this tour program. We went to zoo, saw 3D show which show the evolution of Dinosaurs, went to the lake, Boating, walk on the wooden bridge, and Beach. All enjoyed a lot.

Administration

The following resolutions were taken during the Home management committee meeting

⇒ The chief warden Mr. Augustine explained the regular schedule applied in the home for the children. He also added, since

the children are poor in English, a special coaching is given to the children twice a week.

⇒ A computer teacher was appointed to train the children for basic computer applications twice a week.

⇒ As per the request of the District Child protection unit, the Committee decided to initiate to form a children's club.

Staff meeting

◆ The 3rd STD to 8th STD children entered into the 2nd term.

◆ The helper and cook instructed to clean the vessels and vegetables before using it.

This program was conducted on 30.09.2017 at 5.30 pm at CSI Church, premises Kalakadu. 8 girls participated and received the tuition fees and Nutrition for the month of September 2017.

Nesam Higher studies Program

TANSACS CORE GROUP PROJECT

The APAC – VHS – USAID sponsored STI, HIV/ AIDS Prevention project among Core Groups has completed three years of Yeomen service to the targeted community of Female Sex Workers and Men Having Sex with Men. Now the project had transitioned to the TANSACS for the next 1 year. (April'17 to March'18) Activities:

Following are the activities implemented in the month of Sep '17:

- ◆ Individual HRGs interactions with MSM were 658 and FSW were 688.
- ◆ 7 Group meeting was conducted to FSW and 39 participated.
- ◆ 9 Group meeting was conducted to MSM and 55 participated.
- ◆ Number of HRG's tested in the STI Clinics MSM - 151 , FSW – 159 and PT- 2 (Total :312)
- ◆ Number of ICTC Referral and tested for FSW – 131 and MSM – 102 (Total : 233)
- ◆ 1 DIC level meetings were conducted and 23 HRG's participated

- ◆ 9 Hotspot level meetings were conducted.

(76 HRG's participated)

- ◆ Our ongoing HRG is FSW : 693 and MSM : 685 (Total :1378)

TANSACS TI-MIGRANT PROJECT

- Identified 641 Migrants as HRG.
- Provided One to One to 807 Migrants (New).
- Provided One to One to 163 Migrants (Follow up).
- 83 Group sessions conducted among migrants and 1130 migrants participated in the group.
- 37 Syphilis and 184 migrants tested in the ICTC Camp.
- Counseling services were given to 138 migrant.
- 4 Staff review meeting conducted in our Project office.
- 2 Street Theatre Program conducted various place in Panakudi.
- ICTC Camps conducted in Koodankulam (26), Puzhavankudiyiruppu (37), Panakudi (31), Koodankulam (24), Mavadi (35) and Tirunelveli (31) and 248 migrants participated in Health camp.
- 2 Advocacy meeting conducted in Puzhavankudiyiruppu and Panakudi.
- 2 Demand Generation meeting conducted in Tirunelveli and Panakudi.
- 2 Condom Committee Meeting conducted at various places in Koodankulam.

CARE AND SUPPORT PROJECT

- ⇒ 15 Support Groups were conducted. Out of 194 members, 151 members participated in the meeting.
- ⇒ 3 Block co-ordination meetings were conducted. Out of 39 members, 31 members participated.
- ⇒ 2 Advocacy meetings were conducted with 103 participants.
- ⇒ The LSE - 4 programs were conducted, 64 children participated.
- ⇒ 15 Adolescent clubs are functioning well. Among the 334 members, 325 of them participated.

Medical camp for AWD's:

With the aim of to analyze the medical, psychological and livelihood needs for the AWD's a medical camp was organized. Specialized doctors from Ortho, Psychiatry and general health were invited as the observers for this camp. 22 AWD's from Tirunelveli Corporation and Palayamkottai were participated in this camp.



PRAYER MEETING

The Peace Trust Staff Prayer Meeting was held on 01.09.2017.
