An estimated 1.8 million individuals worldwide became newly infected with HIV in 2017 - about 4,931 new infections per day. This includes 160,000 children under the age of 15 years. There are many needed Orphans and Semi orphans children (affected and living with HIV) in our project who needs financial support to sustain their health and education. Let us remember our commitment to offer holistic education to these children. I am sure, our staff and well wishers would make use of the grand opportunities, contribute on their part, further strengthen and beautify the structure of the society and the nation through our Trust.

## SHARON CHILDREN HOME

### **Introduction:-**

During the month of December, the children prepared well for their Half-Yearly examination. The children received snacks and eatables from their parents during the visitors day. They shared many things with their parents and were happy.

### **Education:-**

As usual, Mr. Chandran, English tutor handles the English Grammar class from 6.00 pm to 7.30 pm every Monday, and Thursday. During this month, a special coaching was arranged before the half yearly examination for 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> students. Mr. Chandran, the English tutor gave special coaching for the boys to write well in the half yearly examination.

### **Computer Class: -**

The computer teacher Mr. Godvinmani attended the home weekly twice. In addition to the computer. He taught the general discipline and practices and motivate the children to talk in English. His service to our home children is very useful and teaching many things in the computer as well as a social discipline within a short period.

### **Health Aspects:-**

In the beginning of December we received heavy rain in our Tirunelveli district. The Government declared 3 days holidays for schools to prevent fever and other diseases. We are glad that any of the home children were not affected by fever and other seasonal diseases.

### **Children competition:-**

The children are regularly attending the karate and sports classes. Twice a week (Saturday and Sunday) Master Murugan is coming and teaching karate and other sports to

brisk the student accordingly. Many of the children are very interested to play cricket. The karate master Mr. Murugan found 7 children eligible to get green belt. They participated the competition and got the certificate from "Indiya Veerakalai Sangam" recognized by the Government of Tamil Nadu. This certificate will be considered by the Government and private sectors during the time of interview for jobs.

### **Administration:-**

Our new Asst. Director, Mr. Francis Sittther visited the project and verified all the documents pertaining to the children. And also checked the whole premises, particularly the cleanliness of the home. The Government health department people are also visiting the home to ensure the waste is segregated in a proper place and free from insects. Our Director, Dr. R. Anburajan gave an instruction to the Asst. Director to visit the home periodically for monitoring.

Sharon Children Home Staff Review Meeting was conducted on 23.12.2017 at 2.30 pm. by the Project Manager, at Sharon Home. children's education and appreciated all the staff for their services.

### **Priyam Girls Program:-**

## CARE AND SUPPORT PROJECT

### **Adolescent with disability assessment camp:**

This camp was conducted at Vasudevanallur block on 3.12.2017. 24 AWDs participated in this camp. Dr. Anushya from Vasudevanallur Government Hospital participated and screened the AWDs problems and found that four children are in use of Aids and appliances. One AWDs referred to Dr. Zipal for surgery. The medical team suggested that after Dr.Sipil arrival from Germany, the date for surgery may be decided. And the doctor suggested that other remaining 3 AWDs children may be in need of appliance immediately in the future. And another 17 were suggested to obtain Government schemes, educational support and vocational training for the respective department.



### **Career Guidance Training:**

This training was conducted by provisions on 10.12.2017. 37 10<sup>th</sup> STD children participated the training. The Provision Counselor Mr. Wilson, Mrs. Saranya MEL officer and Field counselor Mrs. Mari from Peace Trust, the resource person for this career guidance training. The main theme of the training is to select the future course after completion of 10<sup>th</sup> STD. And also they know about the vocational course and to which the available employment in the present situation. Most of them think that the job can only be obtained after completion of higher course. But this training helps to understand that minimum qualification is enough to get employment in our nearest area. All the participants broken their views after attending the training

that they need not go for higher study.

### **World AIDS Day Celebration:**

Both World AIDS day and Nellai Sutram 100<sup>th</sup> EC meeting were celebrated on 9<sup>th</sup> December 2017. The District Program Manager DAPCU and 4 partner NGO Directors, Nellai Sutram EC members, Support group leaders and Field counselors participated. We formed a rally by exhibiting the World AIDS day. After the rally a special meeting was conducted and wished the success of Nellaisutram.

### **ALHIV/AAHIV and AWDS get-together Program:**

The Xavier's Hr. Sec. School Alumni Association organized a Christmas program for the above targeted beneficiaries. Dr. R.
