## RHEMA CSP & CDSP

### CSP Curriculum Meeting

We conducted the CSP curriculum meetings on the following dates of this month in that we shared about the following topics to the mothers through the various methods.

17th June 2017 – How to overcome the shocking situation in your life – 14 mothers were participated

24th June 2017 – Problem solving methods – 11 mothers were participated

### Home Prayer

On June 2017, we conducted the 20 Home Prayers in Different areas. In this home prayer the topic was based on the Bible verse Luke 6:38 "Give, and it shall be given unto you". We prayed for the requested prayer points by the mothers who were participated. Totally 6 CSP mothers, 57 CDSP mothers and 3 others were participated.

### Child in Prayer

### Weekend Activities

On 17th June 2017 we conducted the moral activities, in that we told the story about "losing all the bad habits". 130 children participated in this program

On 24th June 2017 we conducted the moral class to our children. In that we taught about "leave the wrong way: enter in the new way" through the drama. 110 children participated in this meeting.

## Links Peace - MED

Programme is functioning well with 164 beneficiaries being provided with Fund assistance to start viable ventures. The repayment of the beneficiaries is very encouraging making us to give advance to more beneficiaries. At present there are 36 beneficiaries encouraging with MED loan.

## MEDICAL CAMP

Every effort is taken to enhance the life style of the remote Rural Dweller. Medical Camps are held where there are no medical facilities; quality Medical attention is offered at the Medical Camps.

## SHARON CHILDREN HOME

### Education:

I am very happy to submit the new academic year monthly report of June 2017. Almost 21 boys who have studied last year and 10 new boys are enrolled in this academic year. Now the total strength of our Home is 31. In the last year, all the children have passed and entered in the new class. The following Children passed in 10<sup>th</sup> examination and admitted in XI standard.

Mr. Essakimuthu is admitted in B.Sc. (Physics) at St. John's College Palayamkottai.

### Administration:-

Our Assistant Director, Mr.C. Devaraj has got a position in Government and left. At present Mr. N. Sakthi Vijayavel who is working at Peace Trust as Project Manager in Child Development Project looks after the Asst. Director work from June 2017 onwards. He visited the home periodically. Mr. Samuel Franklin one new Tutor-cum Warden was interviewed by Dr. R. Anburajan on 7<sup>th</sup> June 2017 and appointed on 8<sup>th</sup> June 2017.

### Admission:

The total strength of the home is 31 in this

academic year. 10 new boys were selected by conducting interview. The four boys are admitted in 9<sup>th</sup> standard, 4 boys are admitted in 5<sup>th</sup> STD, one boy is admitted in 6<sup>th</sup> standard and one boy is admitted in 10<sup>th</sup> standard.

### Staff meeting:

Sharon Children Home Staff Review Meeting was conducted on 28.06.2017 at 5.30 pm. by the Project Manager. Manager welcomed all the staff for the new academic year 2017-2018. The staff is instructed to conduct weekly test in all classes. The warden Mr. Samuel Franklin is instructed to handle the boys who study 8th standard to XI th standard.

### Priyam Girls Program:-

This program was conducted on 24.06.2017 at 4.00 pm at CSI Church, premises Kalakadu. In this program nine girls participated and received the tuition fees and Nutrition for the month of June 2017.

### Nesam Higher studies Program:

In 2016-2017 the total strength of Nesam higher studies students are 5 under this program.

## TANSACS CORE GROUP PROJECT

The APAC – VHS – USAID sponsored STI, HIV/ AIDS Prevention project among Core Groups has completed three years of Yeomen service to the targeted community of Female Sex Workers and Men Having Sex with Men. Now the project had transitioned to the TANSACS for the next 1 year. (April'17 to March'18).

### The followings are the activities implemented in the month of June '17

- \* Individual HRGs interactions with MSM were 682 and FSW were 691.
- \* 8 Group meetings were conducted to FSW and 57 participated.
- \* 11 Group meetings were conducted to MSM and 67 participated.
- \* Number of HRG's tested in the STI Clinics MSM - 219 , FSW – 215 and PT- 5 (Total :441)
- \* Number of ICTC Referral and tested for FSW – 104 and MSM – 122 ( (Total : 226)
- \* 3 DIC level meetings were conducted and 84 HRG's participated
- \* 9 Hotspot level meetings were conducted. ( 112 HRG's participated)

\* Our ongoing HRG is FSW : 691 and MSM : 686 (Total :1377)

### Important Points:

- We participated in Rally of Universal Blood Donor Day & Human Chain program at V. O. C Ground on 14th June 2017.
- We provided refresher training for Hotspot Analysis & Condom Analysis to PEs.
- Our M&E officer participated in the one day training program at TANSACS chennai on 17th June 2017
- We helped to get ID card for 8 TGs from Social Welfare Department on 19th June 2017.
- On 23rd June 2017, we participated in RRM with 3 district PM and M & E , this meeting conducted by TSU team leader, State M & E Officer, Project Manager, District Program Manager and District supervisor.
- We arranged training to TGs for their improvement of life style at Indian Overseas Bank through Rural Self Employment Training Institute on July month.

## TANSACS TI-MIGRANT PROJECT

- ⇒ 2 Games Program conducted in Kalakad and

Koodankulam

- ⇒ 9 ICTC Camps conducted in Koodankulam 3 (159), Kavalkinaru (92) Kalakad (45) Prancheri (47) Tirunelveli (38) and Chettikulam (52) and 433 migrants participated in Health camp.
- ⇒ 2 Advocacy meeting conducted in Chettikulam and Koodankulam.
- ⇒ 2 Demand Generaion meeting conducted in Kavalkinaru and Chettikulam.

## CARE AND SUPPORT PROJECT

- ◆ 15 Support Groups were conducted. Out of 201 members, 142 members participated in the meeting.
- ◆ 3 Block co-ordination meetings were conducted. Out of 39 members, 33 members participated.
- ◆ Seven friends' forum programs were conducted and 49 members participated.
- ◆ The LSE - 4 programs were conducted, 86 children participated.
- ◆ 13 Adolescent clubs functioning well. Among the 305 members 279 of them participated in the last month meeting.

### ALHIV Training

ALHIV Treatment seeking behavior training was conducted by pro-vision on 03.06.2017. This meeting sessions was handled by Dr. Napoleon and Mrs. Saranya MEL officer from pro-vision. Dr. Napoleon told them to take regular ART, if not taken the ART the side effects happening was told to them briefly. The yoga practice must be a healthy in day to day life. Yoga practice will give a better improvement in physically.

### Advocacy meeting with Officials at Toyota:-

The Advocacy meeting with officials conducted on 07.06.2017 at Toyota office. The senior manager, HR staff and officials participated. Mrs. Mari Field officer and Accountant taught about the project goals and the future achievements of the

project. The ALHIV/AAHIV adolescents are benefitted of this project in the year 2016-2019. They are selected for educational support scheme from 10<sup>th</sup> std to 12<sup>th</sup> Std. RD Accounts opened and operated in Bank for 18 adolescents and discussed. Finally they come to a conclusion to join with our hands to lighten their future life of ALHIV/AAHIV.

### Education AIDS to ALHIV/AAHIV:

This meeting was conducted on 25.06.2017 at Peace Health Centre. 13 ALHIV/AAHIV children participated in this meeting from various blocks in Tirunelveli District. Director Dr. R. Anburajan participated in the meeting and gave educational tips to the ALHIV/AAHIV children. He also gave special message about Knowledge, Understanding and Wisdom.
