Home Prayer

- * On 25th November 2017 we conducted the moral activity class to our children. In that we taught about "Truthfulness" through story telling. 130 children participated in this meeting.

LINKS PEACE - MED

SHARON CHILDREN HOME

Introduction:-

During the month of November 2017, the children are motivated to study well for Half-Yearly examination. The Visitors day in our home is 5th November and 19 children's parents and guardian visited the children. All the children felt happy and shared their love with one another. The children received snacks and eatables things from their parents.

Education :-

The Pre -Half yearly examination finished in 10th and 11th students. The boys received their marks. The half yearly examination started on 11th December 2017. During this month, a special coaching was arranged before the half yearly examination for 10th and 11th students. Mr. Chandran, an English tutor is coaching the boys to write well in the half yearly examination.

Computer Class: -

A teacher voluntarily came to teach the computer for our home children. But due to some commitment he was not able to continue and at our request Mr. Godvinmani again is teaching computer for our children but till December only. His service to our children was very useful and teaching many things in the computer within a short period.

Health Aspects

During the month of November in Tamil Nadu, almost all the district received good rain, particularly our Tirunelveli District. To prevent children getting affected by waterborne diseases, our District Collector announced 4 days holiday for all schools and colleges. Our children are doing very well.

Children competition:

The District child protection unit organized a Drawing and essay writing competition during a children's day celebration on 16th November 2017. Master Joseph, who is in 10th std participated in the essay writing competition and master Muthuraj, who is in 9th std participated in the drawing competition. He got first prize in the Drawing competition.



Staff meeting:

Sharon Children Home Staff Review Meeting was conducted on 30.11.2017 at 6.00 pm to discuss many things related to home and the children education.

Priyam Girls Program

This program was conducted on 18.11.2017 at 5.30 pm at CSI Church, premises Kalakadu. In this program, 8 girls participated and received the tuition fees and Nutrition for the month of November 2017. **Ms. Sofia, who is studying in 2nd year Bachelor of Arts (History Main) is attending the college regularly. She passed the 1st semester and 2nd semester and got 2nd class.**



ARARAT Peace Restoration Home

⇒ In this month of November two old ladies (Mrs. Mary Jebakani and Mrs. Lakshmi) were admitted. Now they are under the care of our nurses. Routine medical checkup and physiotherapy are taking place every day.

⇒ Two de-addiction persons were benefited in this month and one of them went home happily. The next one is waiting to go home in the first week of December.

⇒ One kitchen helper Mrs. Jothi was appointed in this month and preparing delicious food for the inmates and the staff of Ararat.

⇒ We pray that the coming Christmas Season will be a blessing for many people.



TANSACS CORE GROUP PROJECT

The APAC – VHS – USAID sponsored STI, HIV/ AIDS Prevention project among Core Groups has completed three years of Yeomen service to the targeted community of Female Sex Workers and Men Having Sex with Men. Now the project had transitioned to the TANSACS for the next 1 year. (April'17 to March'18)



◆ Number of ICTC Referral and tested for FSW – 94 and MSM – 105((Total : 199)

◆ 2 DIC level meetings were conducted and 45 HRG's participated .

◆ 11 Hotspot level meetings were conducted. (76 HRG's participated)

◆ Our ongoing HRG is FSW : 674 and MSM : 694 (Total :1368)

◆ Identified New HRG -10

Activities:

- ◆ Number of HRG's tested in the STI Clinics MSM - 141 , FSW – 142 and PT- 17 (Total :300)



TANSACS TI-MIGRANT PROJECT

- Identified 598 Migrants as HRG.
- Provided One to One to 1185 Migrants (New).
- Provided One to One to 325 Migrants (Follow up).
- 181 Group sessions conducted among migrants.
- 72 Syphilis and 217 migrants tested in the ICTC Camp.
- Counseling services given to 262 migrant.
- 4 Staff review meeting conducted in our Project office.
- 4 Street theatres Program conducted at various places in

Panakudi.

- 7 ICTC Camps conducted in Panakudi (20), Koottapuli (32), Chettikulam (34), Senkulam (40), Panakudi (37), Mavadi (26), Nakkneri (27) and 207 migrants participated in 4 Health camp.
- 2 Advocacy meeting conducted in Senkulam and Panakudi.
- 2 Demand Generation meeting conducted in Senkulam and Panakudi.
- 1 PLHIV detected in Perinbapuram.

CARE AND SUPPORT PROJECT

- ◆ 15 Support Groups were conducted. Out of 194 members, 164 members participated in the meeting.
- ◆ 3 Block co-ordination meetings were conducted. Out of 39 members, 37 members participated.
- ◆ Advocacy meetings with Educational Institutions conducted with 120 participants.
- ◆ The LSE - 4 programs were conducted, 65 children participated.
- ◆ 15 Adolescent clubs functioning well. Among the 337 members, 324 participated.

Adolescent with disability assessment camp:

This camp was conducted at Kuruvikulam and Sankarankoil block on 5.11.2017. In this camp 22 AWDs participated. Dr. Padmanthan and Dr. Rajamani from the Primary Health Centre Sankarankoil participated and screen the AWDs problems and finds that one AWDs child need operation in both the legs. The medical team suggested that after Dr. Sipil

from German arrives, the date for surgery may be decided. And the doctor advised another 3 AWDs child to use appliance in the future immediately. And the other 18 were suggested to obtain Government schemes from the respective department.

Career Guidance Training:

The training was conducted by Provision on 19.11.2017. In this training, Twenty Seven 10th STD children participated. The provision counselor Mr. Wilson, Mrs. Saranya MEL officer and Field counselor Mrs. Mari, from Peace Trust, were the resource person for this career guidance training. The main theme of the training is to educate the children to select the future course after completion of 10th STD and also for them to know about the Job oriented vocational course. Most of them think that only the job can be obtained after completion of higher course. But this training helps to understand that minimum qualification is enough to get employment at nearby places. All the participants realized that they need not go for higher studies after attending the training.

PRAYER MEETING

Prayer meeting for the Peace Trust Staff was held on 05-10-2017. Mr. Peter from "Jesus Prayer Ministry" shared the word of God from the passage **Exodus 1:21 (Because the midwives feared God, He established households for them.)** The Egypt King ordered the midwives Shiphrah and Puah to kill the male child of the Hebrew women give birth. But they afraid to do it because they feared **God**. So the Lord established their households for them. Through this we learn to fear God only, then He will look after our own problems.
