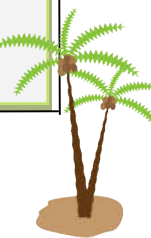

Child in Prayer

We organized the Child in Prayer on 3rd March 2018. We taught about the song "Oru Thanthaiyai Pola yenai Thukki Sumapavar". The meaning of the song is "Jesus lift us as like our father". We conducted the debate about "Father Love, Mother Love, and whose love is greater?". We showed the short films about "the love of Jesus Christ" and all the children involved in the prayer. Totally 90 children participated in the prayer meeting.

Home Prayer

This month we conducted the 15 Home Prayers in different areas. In the home prayer the topic was based on the Bible verse Isaiah 53:5. We prayed the requested prayer points by the participants. In this prayer, 10 CSP mothers, 63 CDSP mothers and 8 others, totally 81 members participated.

Moral Activities Class

⇒ On 10th March 2018, we conducted the moral activity class on "Everything can change by PRAYER" through the Bible character "blind Bartimaeus" from Psalm 145:18. We taught the song "Yellame mara pokuthu". 118 children

were participated in this program.

⇒ On 17th March 2018, we conducted the moral class based on "with God all things are possible". We taught the song "Nothing is too hard for the Lord". And shared the message about "Lazarus was dead came forth". 102 children participated in this meeting.

⇒ We conducted the moral class on 24th March 2018. In that we explain about the "Palm Sunday". We taught the song "Hosana Paduvom ... ". 90 children participated in this meeting.

Students Special Meeting

We organized the Students Special Meeting on 13th March 2018. In that we conducted the group counselling about "How to prepare before the exam, after exam and exam hall management". 17 children participated in this meeting.

LINKS PEACE - MED

Programme is functioning well with 176 beneficiaries being provided with Fund assistance to start viable ventures. The repayment of the beneficiaries is very encouraging making us to give advance to more beneficiaries. At present there are 35 beneficiaries encouraging with MED loan.

Education:

As an annual examination is approaching, the children are very busy in preparing. Some children are writing the Government examination. For 11th standard annual examination started on 7th March 2018. The Tamil 1st paper was their first exam. The tuition teacher and our home tutor were spending more time with them.

Regarding Master Sivakumar and Miss G. Sathya, we conducted exam in our home itself and after our care we find some improvement in Maths and English. So we hope they will do well in the 10th Government Examination. Our English tutor put maximum effort for them. From this year onwards, our Government will conduct common examination for 11th std also. This examination mark will be added to the next 12th examination marks.

Computer Education:

The computer teacher will be appointed for the next academic year (ie June 2018). Meantime, we are looking for a suitable part-time computer teacher also.

Health Aspects:

During this month, children are doing well by the Grace of our Lord Almighty.

Children Recreation:

The children are regularly attending the karate and sports classes. Master Murugan teaches karate and other sports regularly.

Parents meeting for Children Home:



Parents or guardians visited the home on March 4th, 2018 to see their children. The children had a lot of fun with their loved ones. All the parents are welcomed by the Home Manager and then

shared with them, their child's performance in Education and Extra Curricular activities. Also, discussed about admitting the children for the year 2018-2019, their willingness and to give their consent in written. The schools may be closed on or before 20th April 2018. The vacation starts from 28th April 2018.

Home Management Committee meeting:

The monthly Home management committee meeting was conducted on 17th March 2018 at 1.00 pm. Mr. Ganesan from DCPU attended the meeting on behalf of the District child protection officer. During this meeting the Doctor and Counselor not attended due to their busy schedule. The Home Manager welcomed the participants and shared the home activities of the previous month. The previous meeting minutes were read and discussed.



Staff meeting:

Sharon Children Home Staff Review Meeting was conducted on 27.03.2018 at 4.30 p.m by the Project Manager, at Sharon Home to discuss the various activities of children.

Priyam Girls Program:

This program was conducted on 17.03.2018 at 6.00 pm at CSI Church, Kalakadu. In this program, only 8 children participated. Sabia and Maria jasmine not attended for the last two months



ARARAT Peace Restoration Home

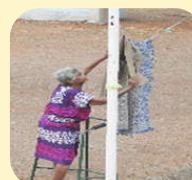
Many good things happened in the month of March 2018. The boy Prince who came here for de-addiction was discharged and went home happily. His parents were glad to see their son as a normal boy.

TANSACS Core Group Project



The APAC – VHS – USAID sponsored STI, HIV/ AIDS Prevention project among Core Groups has completed three years of Yeoman's service to the targeted community of Female Sex

Workers and Men Having Sex with Men. Now the project had transitioned to the TANSACS for the next 1 year. (April'17 to March'18)

- ◆ Individual HRG's interactions with MSM were 675 and FSW were 669.
- ◆ 9 Group meeting was conducted to FSW and 54 participated
- ◆ 8 Group meeting was conducted to MSM and 40 participated.
- ◆ Number of HRG's tested in the STI Clinics MSM - 178 , FSW – 162 and PT- 10 (Total : 350)
- ◆ Number of ICTC Referral and tested for FSW – 116 and MSM – 105 ((Total : 221)
- ◆ 2 DIC level meetings were conducted and 73 HRG's participated

◆ 13 Hotspot level meetings were conducted. (82 HRG's participated)

◆ Our ongoing HRG is FSW : 669 and MSM : 675 (Total :1344)

CARE AND SUPPORT

- ◆ 15 Support Groups were conducted. Out of 194 members, 163 members participated in the meeting.
- ◆ 3 Block co-ordination meetings were conducted. Out of 39 members, 33 members participated.
- ◆ The LSE - 4 programs were conducted, 66 children participated.
- ◆ 15 Adolescent clubs are functioning well. Among the 357 members, 344 of them participated in the last month's meeting.

Visit of Nora of Germany

With the aim to improve the knowledge on the living condition of the project target people, Ms. Nora from Germany visited the Peace trust activities.



Interaction with PLHIV:

Part of the visit, Ms. Nora interacted with Ms. Pattammal the PLHIV in Muthoor and come to know the past life of her before get infected by HIV, life during the initial stage of the infection, and the role of Peace Trust, which helps her to come out of the stigma she underwent, and break the community stigma/medication, treatment facilities and also managing the day to day life and children's education and so on.

Interaction with ALHIV:

The aim of this visit is to make the sponsor understand the importance of the educational support needed for the project children and the contribution from the parents and community. Ms. Nora interacted with the ALHIV Sornam at her home in Samathanapuram, of the corporation area. During this interaction, she realized the need of the monetary support and appreciated the project activities.

Interaction with the Uravugal club members:

With the aim to integrate the development of the adolescent at the village, Ms. Nora visited the Uravugal club at Melakulam. During the interaction, the members explained the role of the club in the multidimensional development of the students and motivating them to have higher education.



Public meeting at Tharuvai with the joint effort of St. Xaviers college:

With the aim of to impart the adolescent psychological issue to the parents and also to the adolescents, the project team organized public meeting at Tharuvai with the joint effort of the Social work department of St. Xaviers College.
