I did take part in the World Federation of Hemophilia Word Congress 2018. held from May 20th to May 24th at Glasgow, Scotland. The meeting was very useful to me

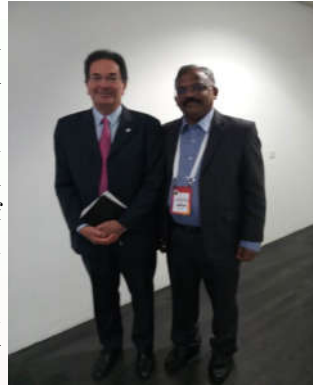

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## RHEMA CSP & CDSP - APRIL

### Moral Activities Class

On 7<sup>th</sup> April 2018, we conducted the moral activity class about the "Don't blame others" through the story. We taught song "Kurai sola matom". 98 children participated in this program.

On 21<sup>st</sup> April 2018, we conducted the moral class about "Helping others". 110 children were participated in this meeting.

### Evening Tuition Class

Regularly we conduct the tuition class on evening. We were teaching the lessons and monitoring the children performance. All children studied for their Annual Exam and wrote their Annual Exam very well. They are expecting results.

### Career Guidance Program

We organized the Career Guidance Program on 21<sup>st</sup> April 2018, to make the children know the career opportunities and the choose their career accordingly. 12 Girls and 9 Boys totally 21 children participated in this meeting.

### RHEMA Academy

We conducted the Competitive exam coaching classes on daily basis and weekend classes also. This classes going very well.

Our senior children are included in the daily classes. It will be useful for their future Govt. Job exams.

### Children Gathering Club Training

Our staff participated in the CGC training held at Triunelveli on 14<sup>th</sup> April 2018. the aim of this trianing program is how to encourage the children and how to conduct the classes.

### Children Gathering Club – One week program

We organized the one week CGC from 23<sup>th</sup> April 2018 to 28<sup>th</sup> April 2018. Topic is "God Love & Live". Every day the children participated very eagerly and joyfully. First 5 days, the participants are 144, 166, 179, 148 and 108 children. The final day program conducted on 28<sup>th</sup> April 2018, the children performed the action song, dance, skit, mime and recited the Memory verses. We gave prizes to the children who participated in the CGC 2018.



## RHEMA CSP & CDSP - MAY

### Children Camp

We conducted the one day children camp for various group of children in the following dates and places. In that camps we motivated the children about Helping to others, Obey to parents & elders, Self-confidence, having Good friends, Team work and Goal achieving through the film show, puppet show, magic show and games.

### Nutrition Awareness Program

On 14<sup>th</sup> May 2018, we organized the Nutrition awareness program for the pregnant mothers and shared about the nutrition health mix product and prepared the nutrition food, conducted by SCAD – Nirman, Cheranmahadevi. Totally 12 mothers participated in the meeting.

### Career Guidance Program

On 15<sup>th</sup> May 2018, we organized the career guidance program for our senior children. Individual counselling was given by Dr. Rathina Prabhu. Asst.Professor, St.John's College, Palayamkottai for boys and his wife Mrs. Sutha Rathina Prabhu, Lecturer, Sardhar Raja Engineering college for girls. In this program 11 boys and 14 girls participated.

### Youth Camp

We conducted the youth camp at Arivanmozhi on 19<sup>th</sup> May 2018. 22 youths participated and know about "how to live a meaningful life".

### 10<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> Results

11 Girls & 6 Boys passed in their 12<sup>th</sup> Standard public exam. Padma got 1040 marks in Accountancy group, Pavithra scored 982 in Maths with Computer science group, Deepalakshmi scored 923 in History Accountancy group and Suhashini got 902 in Maths Biology group.

11 Girls & 14 Boys passed in their 10<sup>th</sup> Standard public exam. First mark in our centre is Tamilarasi 442, second marks is Karthikeyan 398 and Third mark is Udhayakumar 397.

Our child Mas. Kannan who was severely affected by cancer during the year 2014. We gave him the proper medical treatment and support, and he recovered very well by the grace of God. Afterthat we motivated him to continue the studies, but not able to admit in school due to break in 10<sup>th</sup> standard. Child Line refered him to Saranalayam Short Term Home, Tirunelveli (Junction) for further study. So we admitted him in Saranalayam and he studied very well in this home. Now he passed the 10<sup>th</sup> standard public exam with 234 marks out of 500.

### Teens camp

11 Children participated in the Teens camp on 20<sup>th</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2018 at Nalumavadi.

### Academy Class

We conducted the competitive exam coaching class on daily morning. In that 3 Senior Girls & 1 Senior Boy participated in the Academy class regularly.

The 2 nd year examination schedule had not received till date. Also said she is getting good English knowledge and will improve. Also said proud to participate the meeting conducted by the Peace Trust, and getting valuable inputs for examination oriented.

## CARE AND SUPPORT – APRIL

- ◆ 15 Support Groups were conducted. Out of 194 members, 162 members participated in the meeting.
- ◆ 3 Block co-ordination meetings were conducted. Out of 39 members, 34 members participated.
- ◆ The LSE - 4 programs were conducted, 65 children participated.
- ◆ 15 Adolescent clubs functioning well. Among the 357 members 345 of them participated in the last month's meeting.

### Advocacy with Educational Institution:



With the aim to spread the importance of community support at large and tap the financial support to increase the number of higher education among the needy Adolescents,

the advocacy program was organized at the Scad Institution on 12<sup>th</sup> April 2018 at Cherenmahadevi. Around 110 students and teachers participated in this program. The participants assured to support the needy students in the forthcoming academic years.

### Adolescents Education support:

With the aim to continue the higher education of the deprived ALHIV/AAHIV among the working areas, the educational support scheme was established to reduce the Poverty among

the Underprivileged Adolescents project. In this regard, 21 school going adolescents from 10<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> standard were enrolled into the scheme. When they complete 12<sup>th</sup> standard, the scheme will come to an end. During this year, three students educational support scheme comes to an end, yet to use the saved money for their further higher education. Each student saved Rs.2500.00 per month. Of this amount 50% of the money (i.e, Rs.1250.00) was deposited from the project and 25% (i.e, 625.00) of the money was mobilized from the community by the project staff and the remaining 25% (i.e, 625.00) of the money was given by the parents and the total money was saved in the individual joint account with one of their parents.

### Adolescents get together

The adolescent get together was organized by Pro – Vision on 19<sup>th</sup> May 2018 at Florance Swainsain Centre for the deaf. 139 adolescents from working blocks participated in this program.

### NS AGBM

With the aim of to meet the EC members of NS once in a year, NS organized the AGBM with the support of partner organizations. The program was conducted on 26 May 2018. Around 68 NS members and 24 children of the members participated in this program. They show their talents in this program. The New EC members were selected and took a pledge in front of the members.

### Lottery Draw

With the aim of to mobilize the money from the community for the NS to help the members, the lottery draw was planned with the partner NGOs. The collection books were printed and

circulated to the NGOs. In this regards we received 40 books from the organizing team and collected money for the lottery draw. All the books were collected and submitted to organizing committee. In total 40,000 rupees were mobilized from our organization for NS.

### Malteser International Visit

With the aim of to see the activities carried out by the project team and the visible outcome of the project, Mr.Serge from Malteser International visited the project at a field and organization on 25<sup>th</sup> May 2018. During his visit he interacted with the project team on the background, development and meantime impact of the project. He also visited the Vetri adolescent club functioning in Tharuvai village of Palayamkottai block. During his visit the members welcomed him in the traditional way of approach like tie Parivattam, keep Flower garland, Poorana Kumba and taking Aarathi with Parrai. All the activities were done by the members only.



### Skill training to the adolescents

Skill trainings conducted by Pro – Vision, Nagerkoil. Six girls and five boys participated in the training .
