## RHEMA CSP & CDSP

### Child in Prayer

We organized the Child in Prayer meeting for our children on 6th January 2018. Bro. Raja taught songs about "Yettiye Nillu" the meaning of the song is "Keep distance from the sin" and also shared testimony. Our children enacted the drama about the "Kingdom of God". We gave the prayer requests to all the children to pray. Totally 63 children participated in the prayer meeting.

### Home Prayer

This month we conducted 12 Home Prayers in different areas. In the home prayer, the topic was based on the Bible verse 1 John 1:7. We prayed for those who have requested to pray in our Home Prayers. Totally 7 CSP mothers, 52 CDSP mothers and 10 others participated.

### Moral Activities Class

We conducted the moral activity class on 20<sup>th</sup> of this month about "Everything is possible in God's perception" through the Bible story. We shared the topic through the song and story. 40 children participated in this program.

### CSP Mothers Meeting

On 20<sup>th</sup> of this month we conducted the CSP mothers meeting. In this meeting we shared about the word of God based

on the Bible verse Mark 9:23. And also we taught what are the 5 obstacles which reduced our thinking power. 22 mothers participated in this meeting.

### Republic Day Celebration

We organized the Republic Day celebration on 26<sup>th</sup> January 2018. This program started with the word of prayer by Pas.Yesudasan and National flag hoisted by Peace Trust Assistant Director Mr. Francis Sitthar and shared some words about the Republic day. Our girl children gave a word about the History of Republic day and our Boys performed Pyramid and March-past. Mr. Francis Sitthar gave the Star award to the children to achieve the stars for this month. Totally 52 children and 8 mothers participated in this celebration.

### Students Special Meeting

- On 28<sup>th</sup> of this month, we organized the Students Special meeting under the heading "Un Vazhkai Un Kaiyil" (Your Life in Your Hand). Dr. Rathina Prabu, Asst. Professor, St. John's College, Palayamkottai conducted the Career Guidance awareness through the power point presentation and also interacted with our children. 22 Boys, 23 Girls and 2 parents participated in this meeting.

## LINKS PEACE - MED

Programme is functioning well with 174 beneficiaries being provided with Fund assistance to start viable ventures. The repayment of the beneficiaries is very encouraging making us to give advance to more beneficiaries. At present there are 35 beneficiaries encouraging with MED loan.

Every effort is taken to enhance the life style of the remote Rural Dweller. Medical Camps are held where there are no medical facilities; quality Medical attention is offered at the Medical Camps.

## TANSACS Core Group Project



The APAC – VHS – USAID sponsored STI, HIV/ AIDS Prevention project among Core Groups has completed three years of Yeomen service to the targeted community of Female Sex Workers and Men Having Sex with Men. Now the project had transitioned to the TANSACS for the next 1 year. (April'17 to March'18) Activities

◆ 15 Hotspot level meetings were conducted. ( 84 HRG's participated)

◆ Our ongoing HRG is FSW : 662 and MSM : 675 (Total :1337)

◆ Identified New HRG -11

◆ 8 Group meetings were conducted to FSW and 58 participated.

## SHARON CHILDREN HOME

### Introduction:-

After having enjoyed the Christmas holidays all the children return to our Home on 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2018 except one boy named Issac. All the Children were happy on the first day and shared their new year wishes to one another. During this month, 1<sup>st</sup> revision test starts from 17<sup>th</sup> January onwards for 10<sup>th</sup> std children.

### Education-

The half yearly examination marks for our Sharon Home Children have been received.

Master Jeyaram studying in 11<sup>th</sup> std scored very less marks compared to Udayakumar and Sethu. Mr. Samuel Franklin Tutor cum warden was instructed to monitor his studies every day. Master Madesh studying who is in 6<sup>th</sup> std grasping power is less, compared with other home children. So the tutor, Mr. Aruldurai was instructed to check his day to day performance. And also to practice to improve his hand-writing and monitor his class note.

### Computer Class: -

The Suitable part-time computer teacher is not yet available in kalakadu area. So the children themselves practice the materials which they learned from the previous computer Instructor. The computer class is now monitored by the Home Manager and the tutor cum warden.

### Health Aspects

During this month, our home children were not affected by any disease. Generally in this month cold and dew may be high. But this was not affected our home children. Jesus does the miracle each and every time in our home children health.

### Administration:

Mr. Francis Sither, our Assistant Director visited the home on 17.01.2018. On that day he verified the home and monitor all the activities of the children home and also participated in the Home management committee



meeting. During the parents meeting, we requested the Dhonovur Higher Secondary School teachers to send the marks within a week's time after the exam is over, so that we can forward the marks to our sponsor on time. In our home, a re-public day flag hoisting was done by ex Army Mr.Thanaraj from Kalakaddu. After that sweets were distributed to our boys.

### Children competition:

The children are regularly attending the karate and sports classes. Twice a week (Saturday and Sunday) Master Murugan comes and teaches karate and other sports to brisk the student accordingly. Many of the children are very interested to play cricket. Already we purchased the sports materials of cricket to practice the game.

### Home Management Committee meeting:-

The monthly Home management committee meeting was conducted on 17<sup>th</sup> January 2018 at 1.30pm. Mr. Ganesan from DCPU attended the meeting on behalf of the District child protection officer. As per the norms the meeting was conducted and attended by Dr. Alex - Peace Restoration home and a counselor Mrs. Vijayarani.Home Manager welcomed the participants and shared the home activities.

### Priyam Girls Program:-

This program was conducted on 26.01.2018 at 4.00 pm at CSI Church, Kalakadu. In this program, all the 10 girls participated and received the tuition fees and Nutrition for January 2018. The child Suganya studying in 4<sup>th</sup> std is from a very poor family who is a fatherless child. Her mother unfortunately fell down and got fracture.

The Nesam higher study student MS. Matlin Angel and Sofia received their educational marks. They submitted their marks received from their college. Matlin Angel passed all the subjects. Even though studied in Tamil medium, she passed the subject of Anatomy and Physiology which was taught in English. The College Principal appreciated the Matlin Angel and all those who are involved in this program. And the Principal especially thank the sponsor for helping this student.



## CARE AND SUPPORT

- ⇒ 15 Support Groups were conducted. Out of 194 members, 166 members participated in the meeting.
- ⇒ 3 Block co-ordination meetings were conducted. Out of 39 members, 34 members participated.
- ⇒ Advocacy meetings with Educational institutions were conducted with 55 participants.
- ⇒ The LSE - 4 programs were conducted, 65 children participated.
- ⇒ 15 Adolescent clubs are functioning well. Among the 357 members, 347 of them participated in the last month's meeting.

### Adolescent Club Pongal celebration:



With the aim to encourage the adolescent, the adolescent Pongal program was celebrated with the members of adolescent clubs in Tirunelveli district. During this occasion the adolescent club members participated with their parents and involved in the game Uriyadi. The program was conducted on 11th January 2018. Vasanthathin Vasal books were distributed to the participants. Around 75 persons participated in this program

### Advocacy with Educational Institution

With the aim of to motivate the students to support the ALHIV/AAHIV and also decrease the stigma and discrimination in the educational set up the project staff organized the advocacy program with the English department students and professors in St.Johns College on 27.01.2018.



During this program the project staff imported the knowledge on HIV/AIDS, living condition of the ALHIV/AAHIV, available medication, importance of community support to ensure quality higher education for better employment opportunity. 55 students and department professors participated in this program.



## PRAYER MEETING and PRAYER REQUEST

Peace Trust Staff prayer meeting was held on 30-12-2017 as **Thanks Giving Prayer Meeting**. Our Director Dr. R.
