Moral Activity Classes

⇒ On 4th August 2018, we conducted the moral activity class. In that we explained about the “Praise & Pray” through the action song “What did Paul & Silas do in the prison?”. 27 Boys and 44 Girls, totally 71 children participated in this meeting.

⇒ We organized the moral activity class on 11th August 2018. Topic about the “Role Model”. We taught the action song “Dhedi Dhedi Parthen” the meaning of the song is “I was looking for...”. 20 boys and 46 girls, totally 66 children participated.

⇒ We conducted the Moral Activity class on 18th August 2018, the topic about “Obedience”. We taught the action song “*Amma vuku keelpadiyum chinna pilaikal nam*”, the meaning of the song is “We are the obedient children to our Mother & Father”. 33 Boys and 67 Girls, totally 100 children participated

Independence Day Celebration

We organized the Independence Day Celebration on 15th

August 2018. National flag hoisted by **Mr. Jebamani Mathyas**, Head Master, St. John’s Primary School, Vellankuli. Oath taken was lead by the Academy class student, Mrs. Vanobi. Our children performed the March past and dance for “*Vandematharam*” song, Our child Karthiga gave a special speech about “Independence Day” and our Child Sam Allwin spoke about “Bharath Matha”. In this celebration program 28 Boys and 34 Girls, totally 62 children were participated.

Academy Class

We are conducting the competitive exam coaching class daily evening, regularly 3 students are participating and also on every Saturday and Govt. holidays. During the full day classes we teach through videos. In that 11 students are participating. Every class we conducts the model exam and the participants eagerly participates.

LINKS PEACE-MED

Programme is functioning well with 187 beneficiaries being provided with Fund assistance to start viable ventures. The repayment of the beneficiaries is very encouraging making us to give advance to more beneficiaries. At present there are 36 people getting benefits through MED loan.

MEDICAL CAMP

Every effort is taken to enhance the lifestyle of the remote Rural Dweller. Medical Camps are held where there are no medical facilities are available. Quality Medical attention is offered at the Medical Camps.

PRIYAM GIRLS PROGRAMME

- ◆ This program was conducted on 18.08.2018 at 11.30 am at CSI Church Kalakadu., 9 girls participated on that day. Her relatives suggested in diverting her life to go in for job.
- ◆ All the Children are going to tuition regularly. They are advised to study well for the quarterly examination.
- ◆ The 1st mid-term marks were received. In this year some class the Government changed the total syllabus. The teachers are also under training. So the children marks are very low.



TANSACS CORE GROUP PROJECT



The APAC – VHS – USAID sponsored STI, HIV/ AIDS Prevention project among Core Groups has completed three years of Yeomen service to the targeted community of Female Sex Workers and Men Having Sex with Men. Now the project had transitioned to the TANSACS for the next 1 year. (April'18 to March'19)

Followings are the activities implemented in the month of August -18

- ⇒ Individual HRGs interactions with MSM were 657 and FSW were 665.
- ⇒ 5 Group meetings were conducted to FSW and 43 participated.
- ⇒ 4 Group meetings were conducted to MSM and 27 participated.
- ⇒ Number of HRG's tested in the STI Clinics MSM - 82 , FSW – 94 and PT- 14 (Total : 190).

- ⇒ Number of ICTC Referral and tested for FSW – 75 and MSM – 78 ((Total : 153).
- ⇒ 2 DIC level meetings were conducted and 36 HRG's participated.
- ⇒ 9 Hotspot level meetings were conducted. (70 HRG's participated).
- ⇒ Our ongoing HRG is FSW : 675 and MSM : 679 (Total :1354).
- ⇒ Identified New HRG -Nil.

- On 16.08.18 , the students from Rani Anna College came to visit our Peace Trust Main Office for Project Intensive visit. Core Group PCO proceed the program and we explained

about the projects & Programs, Goal and vision. And it was ended with Vote of Thanks by the Rani Annan college students.

MSW Internship Training

- ◇ And for MSW internship, students came from St Xavious College, Palayamkottai, came for two working days. We gave Orientation about the 1) Goal, 2) Objectives, 3) Study's Condom Promotion, 4) Regarding the Activities of Project and Program.
- ◇ We celebrated 72nd Independence Day on 15th August at Peace Health Centre. Our Peace Trust Director, Dr. Anburajan delivered the Message.



CARE AND SUPPORT PROJECT

- 15 Support Groups were conducted. Out of 196 members, 156 members participated in the meeting.
- 3 Block co-ordination meetings were conducted. Out of 39 members, 34 members participated.
- The LSE - 4 programs were conducted, 80 children participated.
- 15 Adolescent clubs are functioning well. Among the 362 members, 355 of them participated in the last monthly meeting.
- INR 10,000 deposited into the Emergency medical care fund.

Educational Support

With the aim of to tap the educational support to the ALHIV/AAHIV and other adolescents in need of the support to continue their education, the project field counselor visits the individual philanthropists, community based organizations and educational institutions. In this regard, the project field counselor visited the STC school and organized the **School Health Awareness** program. From this program she mobilized INR 3000 and used this money for education support to the children affected/ living with HIV.

We are glad to present the report for the month of August 2018.

Cataract operation went on well for **Mrs. Esther** and she is having a good vision now. A new cook Packiyalakshmi took charge on 18-8-2018.

Mrs. Gomathi, who was admitted in our home some months ago was almost bedridden at the time of her admission. Now she is able to walk

and this month onwards she started to help in cooking. Thank be to our God Almighty and to our loving Director, Dr. R. Anburajan and the dedicated nursing staff who took special care and efforts. Because of their love & care, the inmates are keeping in good health and feel homely. Morning and evening prayers are going on regularly. They are enjoying the time in the evening in the open air.
