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## RHEMA CSP & CDSP - September 2018

### *Moral Activity Classes were conducted on following days :*

- ⇒ On 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018, regarding “giving respect and obeying” through Bible story of “Rehoboam” and the action song “No fear when Jesus is with us”. 27 Boys and 44 Girls, totally 71 children participated in this meeting.
- ⇒ On 13<sup>th</sup> September 2018, song “Kaiyalavu Megam Kanum Varai” the meaning of the song is “We pray upto see the blessings”. In this program 43 Boys and 45 Girls, totally 88 children participated.
- ⇒ On 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2018 regarding the story of “King David – How Lord lift up him from Shepard to King?” and the action song “Praising Lord without shame”. IN this meeting 55 children participated.

### *Skit Night Program :*

We conducted the Skit Night Programme at Melakulam CSI Church on 8<sup>th</sup> September 2018. In that we shared the message about “Prayer, Fellowship and Giving” through the songs, skit and debate. All the church believers and village people were very well participated.

### *Child Safety Class :*

We organized the Child Safety class on 24<sup>th</sup> september 2018, conducted by Mr. Thangaraj. Totally 31 children participated. We conducted the film show about Child Safety awareness on 27<sup>th</sup> September 2018. Totally 35 children participated.

### *Health Class :*

We conducted the health class on 25<sup>th</sup> September 2018, totally 23 children participated.

### *Personality Development Class :*

On 26<sup>th</sup> September 2018, we conducted the personality development class, totally 38 children participated.

### *Academy Class :*

We are conducting the competitive exam coaching class daily morning and evening. The students are participating regularly. And also full day class conducting on every Saturday and on Govt. Special classes also conducted, average participation 5 studentns. Totally 12 students participated.

### *Chain Prayer :*

We Organized the chain prayer on 29<sup>th</sup> September 2018, and 13 Church believers, 12 project mothers and 6 children participated. Total 31 participants.

### *Kids Camp :*

- ◆ On 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2018, 25 children participated in the KIDS camp at Jesus Redeems, Nalumavadi. The children enjoyed in the singing time, story time, skit and puppet show. In this camp, 16 children participated in the Bible Exam, and 4 children got prize and 1 child (Karthiga – 9<sup>th</sup> Standard) got consolation prize.

### *Youth Meeting (Valamana Valibam) :*

- ◆ Host of Christ church organized the Valamana Valibam meeting for youth on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2018. In this meeting 36 senior children participated. The word of God shared by Pastor.Jacob Koshy and testimony shared by Pas.Daniel Jawahar.

### *Moral Activity Classes :*

- ◆ We conducted the moral activity class on 13<sup>th</sup> October 2018, in that we taught about “OBEY” through the skit and the action song “Padi elama madi mela yera mudiuma” the meaning of the song is “Without steps (staircase) we can't go to upstairs”. 36 children participated in this meeting.

### *Senior Children Meeting (Memory Power) :*

- ◆ On 18<sup>th</sup> October 2018, we organized the senior chil-

dren meeting about “how to increase the memory power”. Mr. Reuban explained the study techniques through the powerpoint presentation and short films. Mr.Thangaraj conducted the Physical activities class and brain stimulating games. Mr. Vijay Barnabas shared about "What good habits to follow" to increase the memory power. In this half day program, 36 children got benefitted.

### *Academy Class :*

- ◆ We gave the coaching up to date questions, answers and solutions. 5 project senior children and 3 others, totally 8 students attended in the RRB (Railway Recruitment Board) – CBT (Computer Based Test).

### *Parents Meeting :*

- ◆ We organized the cluster level parents meeting for Children Development and Safety Deepawali on 29<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> October 2018. We conducted in 8 cluster areas, totally 68 mothers participated in these meetings.

### *Chain Prayer:*

We Organized the chain prayer on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2018, 18 Church believers, 13 project mothers and 2 children participated, total 33 participated.

## Links Peace Med - September & October 2018

Programme is functioning well with 188 beneficiaries being provided with Fund assistance to start viable ventures. The repayment of the beneficiaries is very encouraging making us to give advance to more beneficiaries. At present there are 34 people getting benefits through MED loan.

## Medical Camp- September & October 2018

Every effort is taken to enhance the lifestyle of the remote Rural Dweller. Medical Camps are held where there are no medical facilities available. Quality Medical attention is offered at the Medical Camps.

- ⇒ Mrs. JeyaChristy and Mrs. Esther also went for eye checkup to Agarwal Eye Hospital.
- ⇒ Gnanaseeli who is a psychiatric patient was admitted in the home in this month of September.



## "Ararat" Peace Restoration Home - October 2018

One of our inmates Mrs. Ananthi, who is a Post Graduate in Master of Computer Application, came to our Home six months ago, with no one to help her. She accepted Christ as her saviour and this made her husband, in-laws and her parental side to be angry. This created many problems in her family life. She left her husband and children and was wandering many places to stay safe, before reaching us. She has no one to support her either from her in-laws and parental side. This trauma made her sick and was in need of Psychiatric treatment.

First, she went to Nalumavadi for prayer and after the prayer she does not know where to go and was directed by someone to see Dr.R.Anburajan. Finally she came to see our Director, Dr.R.Anburajan and he has put her in the

Ararat Home.

Dr.R.Anburajan took special care and gave her counselling. Meantime we tried to contact her husband and convinced her to take her back. After many calls, he promised to take his wife back. and started talking to his wife over the phone. After proper counselling and medication she was doing well and joined as a receptionist in Peace Health Centre. After two months, her husband called her back. She happily went with her husband and reunited with her family after two years.



## TANSACS Core Group Project - September & October 2018

The APAC – VHS – USAID sponsored STI, HIV/ AIDS Prevention project among Core Groups has completed three years of Yeomen service to the targeted community of Female Sex Workers and Men Having Sex with Men. Now the project had transitioned to the TANSACS for the next 1 year. (April'18 to March'19)

### *Following are the activities implemented :*

Individual HRGs interactions with MSM were 657 and FSW were 665.

- ◆ 6 Group meeting was conducted to FSW and 35 participated.
- ◆ 5 Group meeting was conducted to MSM and 28 participated.
- ◆ Number of HRG's tested in the STI Clinics MSM - 44 , FSW – 50 and PT- 24 (Total : 118)

- ◆ Number of ICTC Referral and tested for FSW – 59 and MSM – 52 (Total : 111)
- ◆ 2 DIC level meetings were conducted and 42 HRG's participated
- ◆ 10 Hotspot level meetings were conducted. (63 HRG's participated)
- ◆ Our ongoing HRG is FSW : 676 and MSM : 679 (Total :1355)
- ◆ Identified New HRG FSW-1



## Priyam & Nesam Project - September 2018

Priyam girls monthly program was held on 13-09-2018.

- ◆ All the girls and a few parents were present.
- ◆ Nesam project Ms.Madlin Angel, who is studying in nursing College also came on that day. She was delighted to enter into her 3rd year and was thankful to the sponsors.

- ◆ We had remitted the 3rd year tuition fees.
- ◆ Monthly nutrition pack and tuition fees were given to them. All the children were happy.



## Priyam & Nesam Project - October 2018

Mr. David Johnson, Program In-charge met the girls in Priyam project on 18.10-2018

- ⇒ Seven girls and their parents were present.
- ⇒ Nesam project Boy Essakimuthu who is studying in B. Sc Physics had also come on that day.
- ⇒ He shared about his fee details and about the industrial visit during the month of December 2018.
- ⇒ Gave health tips for girls to follow during raining season to avoid water borne diseases. They both

showed interest to study the nursing course and so I advised them to score good marks in biology and other relevant subjects.

- ⇒ Visited the sick children at their home.
- ⇒ Nine children received their monthly nutrition pack and tuition fees.

## Care and Support Project - September 2018

- 15 Support Groups were conducted. Out of 196 members, 158 members participated in the meeting.
- 3 Block co-ordination meetings were conducted. Out of 39 members, 33 members participated.
- The LSE - 4 programs were conducted, 82 children participated.
- 15 Adolescent clubs functioning well. Among the 362 members 354 of them participated in the last month meeting.

### Completion of Educational Support

With the aim of to continue the higher education of the deprived ALHIV/AAHIV among the working areas, the educational support scheme was established into the Poverty Reduction among Underprivileged Adolescents project. In this regard, 21 school going adolescents from 10<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> standard were enrolled into the scheme. When they complete 12<sup>th</sup> standard, the scheme came to an end. During this reporting month, four students completed their 12<sup>th</sup> standard and the education



support scheme. They used the saved money as the seed money for higher education. During this year, three students completed their educational support scheme, yet to use the saved money for their higher education. All the three students were enrolled at the beginning of their 12<sup>th</sup> standard and saved the money for one year. Each student saved Rs.2500.00 per month. From this amount 50% of the money (i.e, Rs.1250.00) was deposited from the project and 25% (i.e, 625.00) of the money was mobilized from the community by the project staff and the remaining 25% (i.e, 625.00) of the money was given by the parents and the total money was saved in the individual joint account with one of their parents.
