TANSACS CORE GROUP PROJECT

The APAC – VHS – USAID sponsored STI, HIV/ AIDS Prevention project among Core Groups has completed three years of Yeomen service to the targeted community of Female Sex Workers and Men Having Sex with Men. Now the project had transitioned to the TANSACS for the next 1 year. (April'18 to March'19)

Following are the activities implemented in the month of December 2018

- ◇ Individual HRGs interactions with MSM were 680 and FSW were 673.
- ◇ 4 Group meetings were conducted to FSW and 36 participated.
- ◇ 6 Group meetings were conducted to MSM and 34 participated.
- ◇ Number of HRG's tested in the STI Clinics MSM - 33 , FSW – 40 and PT- 47 (Total : 120)
- ◇ Number of ICTC Referral and tested for FSW – 72 and MSM – 53 ((Total : 125)
- ◇ 1 DIC level meetings were conducted and 21 HRG's participated

◇ 10 Hotspot level meetings were conducted. (70 HRG's participated)

Our ongoing HRG is FSW : 678 and MSM : 681 (Total :1359)

Important Points:

- World AIDS Day Observation was conducted at the Tirunelveli Collectorate on 01.12.2018. Theme of the World AIDS day of this year is "KNOW YOUR STATES". The District Collector, DPM, DS participated, in addition to this, all ICTC/STI counselors, LTs and all TI NGOs staff were present. All had taken oath.
- CBS Tested at Radhapuram hot spot on 20.12.2018
- Key village programme for Manaloor on 22.12.2018
- HIV Screening and Sport meet programme conducted at anna stadium on 29.12.2018.



CARE AND SUPPORT PROJECT

- ◆ 15 Support Groups were conducted. Out of 196 members, 150 members participated in the meeting.
- ◆ 3 Block co-ordination meetings were conducted. Out of 39 members, 30 members participated.
- ◆ The LSE - 4 programs were conducted, 82 children participated.
- ◆ 15 Adolescent clubs are functioning well. Among the 358 members, 353 of them participated.

World AIDS day Health Awareness programme:



With the aim of to create awareness at large, World AIDS day was observed on 13.12.2018. Awareness program was organized at St. Johns Boys HR. Sec. School, Palayamkottai. 850 students from 9th – 12th standard participated in this awareness program. Basic Knowledge on HIV/AIDS, STI, window period, HIV testing and treatment centers, ART drugs, ART centers, HIV/TB co-infection Management were imported to the students.

Training on Carrier guidance to Adolescents:

With the aim of to select the right course and continue higher education for a better job opportunity in future, Pro – Vision organized the training program for adolescents on 23.12.2018 at Govt. Hr. Sec. School, Sankarankovil, regarding the career guidance. 54 Adolescents from Sankarankovil, Kuruvikulam and Vasudevanalloor participated in this program. The program was fruitful to the participants.
