In the month of February, the Peace Trust did numerous activities. To start with, the tailoring unit has been started on a Rhema project for the empowerment of the women in these villages and training was given to them on 13.02.2019, in this regard. With a view to curbing the effects of plastic on the environment, the Tamil Nadu Government announced a ban of non-biodegradable and single-use plastic and had recommended the use of natural, environmentally-friendly products. Eighteen Women participated and the cloth materials were given to twelve women to start sewing the bag.

The students from the Nehru Nursing College visited our project on 23.02.2019 as a part of their project visit.

On Feb 4th, we observed World Cancer day at the Tirunelveli District Collectorate. This important day highlights the need for ur-

gent action to increase cancer prevention, early detection, screening and diagnosis to save lives. We want people to know that many cancers can be managed and even cured, especially if they are detected and treated as early as possible.

Moral Activity Classes:-

On 2nd of this month, we conducted the moral activity class, based on the story of “Esther”. Psalm 113:7 says “He raises the poor from the dust and lifts the needy from the ash heap”. In this class 60 children participated.

We conducted the moral activity class on 8th February 2019, about “How the truthful man get the blessing from God?” based on the story of “Mordecai” in the books of Esther. Proverb 28:20 says “A faithful man will abound with blessings”. In this class 78 children participated.

On 16th February 2019, we conducted the moral activity class, about “Butterfly anen paranthu ponen” the meaning of the song “God’s creation is always beautiful” and games conducted about the topic “Help to others”. In this class 70 children participated in this meeting.

Monthly Fasting Prayer Meeting:-

On 9th of this month, we organized the monthly fasting prayer meeting, In this meeting church believers, project mothers and village people participated. Total 35 persons.

Tailoring Unit Training Program:-

We organized the Tailoring unit Training program on 13th February 2019. 18 mothers participated in the training program and 12 mothers received the cloth bag materials.

Adolescent Counselling Program:-

On 14th of this month, we conducted the group counselling about the “Love and affairs” to the adolescent children, in this program 35 children participated.

Chain Prayer :-

We organized the Chain Prayer On 23rd February 2019. 20 Church believers, 19 project mothers and 8 children prayed individually for their personal family needs, totally 47 persons participated.

Links Peace - MED

The Programme is functioning well with 193 beneficiaries being provided with Fund assistance to start viable ventures. The repayment of the beneficiaries is very encouraging making us to give advance to more beneficiaries. At present there are 32 people getting benefits through MED loan. The defaulters of MED Loan beneficiaries insisted to repay the amount as early as possible

Every effort is taken to enhance the lifestyle of the remote Rural Dweller. Medical Camps are held where there are no medical facilities available. Quality Medical attention is offered at the Medical Camps.

Mr. David Johnson, Program In-charge met the girls in Priyam project on 17-02-2019. 8 girls and their parents were present. They were encouraged to sing a song before the meeting. The children of 12thstd and 10thstd are preparing well for their Annual examination. The Annual Examination for 12thstd starts on 1st March. The 10thstd examination will start on 14th March 2019. All the mothers were advised to take care of their children during the study time.

The summer starts and since it is too hot, the children were advised not to go outside during the time of study holidays to avoid the seasonal diseases. Examination tips were given for 10th and 12thclass children. They attended the meeting

with enthusiasm. The other children were also advised to prepare well for their annual examination. At the end of the meeting the tuition fees and Nutrition were distributed. The children were so happy to receive it. The mothers and the grandmothers of the children were also presented.

TANSACS CORE GROUP PROJECT

The APAC – VHS – USAID sponsored STI, HIV/ AIDS Prevention project among Core Groups has completed three years of Yeomen service to the targeted community of Female Sex Workers and Men Having Sex with Men. Now the project had transitioned to the TANSACS for the next 1 year. (April'18 to March'19)

Activities:

Following are the activities implemented in the month of February-19:

- * Individual HRGs interactions with MSM were 684 and FSW were 680.
- * 5 Group meetings were conducted to FSW and 22 participated.
- * 6 Group meetings were conducted to MSM and 29 participated.
- * Number of HRG's tested in the STI Clinics MSM - 59, FSW – 34 and PT- 8 (Total : 101)
- * Number of ICTC Referral and tested for FSW – 43 and MSM – 68 (Total : 111)
- * 2 DIC level meetings were conducted. (40 HRGs partici-

pated)

- * 10 Hotspot level meetings were conducted. (75 HRGs participated)
- * Our ongoing HRG is FSW : 680 and MSM : 684 (Total :1364)
- * CBS tested MSM: 22 and FSW: 33
- * Identified New HRG -5

CARE AND SUPPORT PROJECT

- ⇒15 Support Groups were conducted. Out of 196 members, 154 members participated in the meeting.
- ⇒3 Block co-ordination meetings were conducted. Out of 39 members, 32 members participated.
- ⇒The LSE - 8 programs were conducted, 165 children participated.
- ⇒15 Adolescent clubs functioning well. Among the 358 members, 351 of them participated in the last month's meeting.
- ⇒26 Adolescents were counseled during this reporting month.

Intensive visit of Nursing students:

The students from Nehru Nursing college visited Peace Trust on 23.02.2019. During this visit the students interacted with the Project staff and improved their knowledge on the project implementation, project field works, the

role of government departments to ensure the better living condition of the downtrodden people from the community. The role of the field staff in each project to identify the target people at the villages, enrolled them into the mainstream services and uplift their living status.

Exposure visit of NMCT to Nellai Sutram:

The district level PLHIV federation initiated from the NMCT, Coimbatore visited Nellai Sutram and interacted with the staff and office bearer of Nellai Sutram about the project.
