RHEMA CSP & CDSP

Moral Activity Classes:-

Conducted the moral activity classes :

⇒ On 2nd March 2019 taught the action song about “Obedience” and also the story of “Esther” (“**Mordecai**”) based on the Bible verse Isaiah 53:17 which says “no weapon that is fashioned against you shall succeed”. All children prayed for the requested prayer point. Special prayer was conducted for 10th, 11th, 12th and all classes children’s annual exam. 68 children participated.

⇒ On 8th of this month, Gospel Team, from Veeravanaloor shared the story of “David”, the Bible verse 1 Samuel 18:14 which says “David behaved wisely in all his ways, and the Lord was with him”. 75 children participated.

⇒ On 16th March 2019, taught the song “**Yesuvin Pinne Nanum Pokiren**” the meaning of the song “I’m going behind Jesus” and story about “Esther”. 67 children participated.

⇒ On 22nd March 2019 taught the action song based on “**Kaakaa kuruvi yellam Kathuthu**” the meaning of the song is “**All birds are searching God through singing**” and shared the story about “**Zacharias & Elizabeth**” based on the Bible verse Luke 1:13 which says “your prayer is heard”. In this class 47 children were participated.

⇒ On 27th March 2019, “the crucifixion of Jesus Christ” was taught and from the bible verse John 1:9 which says “That was the true Light which gives light to every man

coming into the world” .65 children were participated.

Monthly Fasting Prayer Meeting:-

We plan to organize the Monthly Fasting Prayer on second Saturday of every month from this year 2019 onwards. This month we conducted on 9th March 2019 and were attended by the church believers, project mothers and village people. Totally 50 parents and 45 children participated in this meeting.

Exam Tips Program:-

We conducted the Exam Tips program on 9th March 2019, in this meeting 10th, 11th and 12th standard children participated. The object of this program is to make the children to understand “**How to face the Exam with confidence and how to prepare well?**”. Totally 20 children participated in this Program. .

Adolescent Counselling Program:-

On 14th of this month, we conducted the group counselling about the “**Love and affairs**” to the adolescent children, in this program 35 children participated.

Chain Prayer:-

On 30th March 2019, we organized the Chain Prayer, and 26 Church believers, 19 project mothers and 9 children attended and prayed individually for their personal family needs.

Totally 54 persons participated.



Links Peace - MED

Program is functioning well with 194 beneficiaries being provided with Fund assistance to start viable ventures. The repayment of the beneficiaries is very encouraging making us to give advance to more beneficiaries. At present there are 33 people getting benefits through MED loan. The defaulters of MED Loan beneficiaries insisted to repay the amount as early as possible.

Medical Camp

Every effort is taken to enhance the life style of the remote Rural Dweller. Medical Camps are held where there are no medical facilities available. Quality Medical attention is offered at the Medical Camps.

During the month of March, the children of 12thstd, 10thstd and 11thstd wrote their Government examinations. The results will be published for 12thstd on April 19th. The 10thstd results will be published on April 29th and the 11thstd results will be published on May 8th.

As this year the annual vacation is long, the children expressed their interest to learn vocational courses. Four children joined tailoring and typewriting classes. It is a two month course for tailoring and 6 month course for typewriting. In the end they can get Government certificate

for typewriting course.

Monthly nutritious support and tuition fees was given to the children.

Nesam Higher study program conducted on 16.03.2019 at 11.30 am. 3 students attended the meeting.

TANSACS Core Group Project



The APAC – VHS – USAID sponsored STI, HIV/ AIDS Prevention project among Core Groups has completed three years of Yeomen service to the targeted community of Female Sex Workers and Men Having Sex

with Men. Now the project had transitioned to the TANSACS for the next 1 year. (April'18 to March'19)

Activities:

Following are the activities implemented in the month of February-19:

- * Individual HRGs interactions with MSM were 683 and FSW were 670.
- * 4 Group meetings were conducted to FSW and 32 participated.
- * 6 Group meetings were conducted to MSM and 35 participated.
- * Number of HRG's tested in the STI Clinics MSM - 57, FSW - 59 and PT- 36 (Total : 152)
- * Number of ICTC Referral and tested for FSW - 88 and MSM - 66 (Total : 154)
- * 2 DIC level meetings were conducted. (36HRGs participated)

- * 10 Hotspot level meetings were conducted. (74 HRGs participated)
- * Our ongoing HRG is FSW : 681 and MSM : 687 (Total :1368)
- * Identified New HRG -4

Care & Support Project

- ⇒15 Support Groups were conducted. Out of 196 members, 145 members participated in the meeting.
- ⇒3 Block co-ordination meetings were conducted. Out of 39 members, 32 members participated.
- ⇒The LSE - 16 programs were conducted, 350 children participated.
- ⇒15 Adolescent clubs functioning well. Among the 358 members, 346 of them participated in the last month's meeting.
- ⇒16 Adolescents were counseled during this reporting month.

Advocacy program : with the aim of to mobilize the community contribution, to continue the education of the students those who were enrolled into the educational support scheme and to create enabling environment to the adoles-

cents the project, the Advocacy program was organized at Mano College, Sankarankovil. 180 students participated.

School LSE: To identify the adolescents with slow learning skill, AILH/AAHIV/broken family/ orpan and semi orphan and risk to lead the life LSE session was organized. In this regard, eight new groups were initiated and meet once in the month and conducts the sessions to face their real life challenge and lead the life for better future. Induction/knowing themselves/critical thinking/ good touch bad touch / reaching goal / decision making were the major sessions taken. 85 students participated in this program.
