## RHEMA CSP & CDSP

### Summer Computer Course:

Rhema project organized a summer computer course for children who are interested to learn a basic computer course, jointly with the APEX computers, Cheranmahadevi. In this regard, on 1st April 2019, the inaugural function was held and, Mr.Ravi, Director, APEX computers shared his inputs. The information was very informative to the participants.

18 children participated on the first day itself. The topics are Fundamentals, MS-Word, MS-Excel, MS-Power point and Internet usage. Two hour theory class in common and one hour practical class will be conducted batch wise.

### Activities:

- \* The monthly fasting prayer was held on 13th April 2019, conducted by **Pas.Yesudasan**. In this meeting church believers, project mothers and village people also participated, totally 50 mothers and 39 children participated.
- \* On 20th April 2019, Chain Prayer was held and 18 Church believers, 13 project mothers and 6 children prayed individually for their personal family needs, totally 37 persons participated.
- \* 6 Boys & 4 Girls, who wrote the 12th Standard public

exam were passed in their exam. Out of 600 marks, Venkatesh.B got 447, Jey Rajesh Kumar.M got 403 marks, in Maths Biology group. And Durgadevi got 409 marks in the Home Science group.

- \* 11 Girls & 10 Boys, who wrote the 10th Standard public exam were passed.



## LINKS PEACE-MED

Program is functioning well with 195 beneficiaries being provided with Fund assistance to start viable ventures. The repayment of the beneficiaries is very encouraging making us to give advance to more beneficiaries. At present there are 29 people getting benefits through MED loan. The defaulters of MED Loan beneficiaries insisted to repay the amount as early as possible.

## MEDICAL CAMPS

Every effort is taken to enhance the lifestyle of the remote Rural Dweller. Medical Camps are held where there are no medical facilities available. Quality Medical attention is offered at the Medical Camps.

## TANSACS CORE GROUP PROJECT



The APAC – VHS – USAID sponsored STI, HIV/ AIDS Prevention project among Core Groups has completed three years of Yeomen service to the targeted community of Female Sex Workers and Men Having Sex with Men. Now the project had transitioned to the TANSACS for the next 1 year. (April'19 to March'20)

### Activities:

### The Following are the activities in the month of April-19:

- \* Individual HRGs interactions with MSM were 697 and FSW were 665.
- \* 5 Group meetings were conducted to FSW and 49 participated.
- \* 6 Group meetings were conducted to MSM and 44 participated.
- \* Number of HRG's tested in the STI Clinics MSM - 31, FSW – 46 and PT- 83 (Total : 160)
- \* Number of ICTC Referral and tested for FSW – 83 and MSM – 90 (Total : 173 )
- \* 1 DIC level meeting was conducted. ( 21 HRG's partici-

pated)

- \* 10 Hotspot level meetings were conducted. ( 93 HRG's participated)
- \* Our ongoing HRG is FSW : 688 and MSM : 700 (Total :1388)
- \* Identified New HRG -20

## CARE & SUPPORT PROJECT

- 15 Support Groups were conducted. Out of 196 members, 146 members participated in the meeting.
- 3 Block co-ordination meetings were conducted. Out of 39 members, 32 members participated.
- The LSE - 12 programs were conducted, 265 children participated.
- 15 Adolescent clubs are functioning well. Among the 358 members, 342 of them participated in the last month's meeting.
- 41 Adolescents were counseled during this reporting month.

### Advocacy program:

With the aim of to mobilize the community contribution, and to continue giving support to the students who were enrolled in the Educational Support Scheme, a advocacy program was conducted in Rose Mary College, Tirunelveli. 150 students participated.



## PRIYAM & NESAM PROJECT

### Activities:

- ⇒ The Monthly meeting for Priyam and Nesam girls was held at Kalakadu on 24th April and the monthly nutrition pack was given to the children. Out of 10, 8 children participated.
- ⇒ The first meeting for new Nesam Program beneficiaries was held at Velankuzhi and Kalakadu. The students were given counselling to choose a course which is suitable for them.
- ⇒ The first monthly meeting was held at Vellankuzhi
- ⇒ The 12th class children results were declared and all were passed.



⇒ 15 students from Vellankuzhi area who were under Rhema, Peace Trust are selected under Nesam Higher study program.

- ⇒ Some children wanted to spend the summer vacation useful and hence joined the Vocational courses.

### Recent updates:

- 1) One of the beneficiary who is doing final year BE got a job In Chennai Everep (Mobile Battery Company) through the placement.
- 2) Another Beneficiary who is doing final year Mechanical also got a job in Hyndai Car company with a starting salary Rs.14,400 + incentive Rs.1050 and other benefits.
