Summer Computer Course:

We conducted the theory and practical exam on 1st June 2019. The summer computer students did their exam very well. We started the summer computer course from this year 2019, it was very useful to the students.

Monthly Parents Meeting:

On 8th June 2019, the monthly parents meeting was held, which was conducted by Mr. Daniel Dhanasingh. In this meeting, project mothers and children participated, totally 54 mothers and 49 children participated.

Moral Activity Class:

- * We organized the moral activity class on 15th June which was conducted by Mr. John and Mrs. Chitra John from Viruthunagar. 81 children participated very actively.
- * On 28th June 2019, in the moral activity class, we taught the Hindi action song based on "How to submit our sin to the Lord's feet". 75 children participated very eagerly.
- * A well wisher celebrated her birthday along with our children and provided dinner. The children were so happy to eat chicken Briyani after long.

Individual Counselling Day:

On every month last Saturday, we organized the individual counseling to the children and their parents. Individual counseling day was conducted on 29th of this month. 21 children, 18 mothers and 3 fathers, totally 42 participants got the benefits through this program.

Monthly meeting for Senior Children:

On 29th June 2019, we organized the senior children monthly meeting. 15 senior girls, 4 senior boys and 2 parents, total participants 21 participated.



LINKS PEACE-MED

The program is functioning well with 200 beneficiaries been provided with Fund assistance to start viable ventures. The repayment of the beneficiaries is very encouraging making us to give advance to more beneficiaries. At present there are 24 people getting benefits through MED loan. The defaulters of MED Loan beneficiaries insisted to repay the amount as early as possible.

MEDICAL CAMP

Every effort is taken to enhance the lifestyle of the remote Rural Dweller. Medical Camps are held where there are no medical facilities available. Quality Medical attention is offered at the Medical Camps.

TANSACS CORE GROUP PROJECT

The APAC – VHS – USAID sponsored STI, HIV/ AIDS Prevention project among Core Groups has completed three years of Yeomen service to the targeted community of Female Sex Workers and Men Having Sex with Men. Now the project had transitioned to the TANSACS for the next 1 year. (April'19 to March'20)

Activities:

Following are the activities implemented in the month of June-19:

- * Individual HRG's interactions with MSM were 701 and FSW were 666.
- * 4 Group meetings were conducted to FSW and 32 participated.
- * 6 Group meetings were conducted to MSM and 39 participated.
- * Number of HRG's tested in the STI Clinics MSM -83 , FSW – 67 and PT- 15 (Total : 165)
- * Number of HRG's tested in the ICTC Clinics MSM – 82 and FSW – 83 (Total : 165)

- * 2 DIC level meetings were conducted. (40 HRG's participated)
- * 10 Hotspot level meetings were conducted. (71HRG's participated)
- * Our ongoing HRG is FSW : 653 and MSM : 689 (Total :1342)
- * Identified New HRG -5

CARE AND SUPPORT PROJECT

- ⇒ 15 Support Groups were conducted. Out of 196 members, 151 members participated in the meeting.
- ⇒ 3 Block co-ordination meetings were conducted. Out of 39 members, 31 members participated.
- ⇒ The LSE - 8 programs were conducted, 268 children participated.
- ⇒ 15 Adolescent clubs functioning well. Among the 358 members 349 of them participated in the last month's meeting.
- ⇒ 10 Adolescents were counseled during this reporting month.

World Environment Day: with the aim of to create awareness about the environment, the project team decided to organize an awareness to different stakeholders in working areas. In this regard, 11 villages were selected with the coordination of existing adolescent clubs with other community based forums such as Schools, Government departments like a social welfare

board, department of forestry, Tamilnadu Women's corporation and Block offices.

Also create awareness on sanitation, Usage of solid waste management, Tree plantation, construction and usage of household toilets, avoid plastic usage and promote cloth bags.
