Moral Activity Class

⇒ On 7th September 2019, we conducted the Moral Activity class. Children wished the children who celebrated their birthday in the last week. 25 boys and 46 girls, totally 71 children participated very actively.

⇒ We organized the moral activity class on 20th September 2019 which was conducted by Mr. Richard and his wife. The topic about “Good Shepherd” and taught the new song and story about the “lost sheep”. In this class 83 children participated.

⇒ We conducted the moral activity class on 21st September 2019, started with the game time. 23 boys and 36 girls, totally 59 children participated very eagerly.

Monthly Special Meeting

We conducted the monthly special meeting on 14th September 2019. In this meeting, 2 fathers, 18 mothers and 24 children participated.

Monthly meeting for Senior Children

We organized the monthly meeting for the senior children on 27th September 2019. Mr. David Johnson conducted the meeting and shared about the “Importance of Studies”. In this meeting 15 girls participated in the Priyam girls program. 2 boys participated in the Nesam Higher studies

program.

Individual Counselling Program

On 28th September 2019, we conducted the individual counseling Program for children and their parents. Individual counseling were given to one child and one mother.

Chain Prayer

We organized the Chain Prayer on 28th September 2019, totally 47 participants prayed for their needs.



Links Peace - MED

Program is functioning well with 202 beneficiaries being provided with Fund assistance to start viable ventures. The repayment of the beneficiaries is very encouraging making us to give advance to more beneficiaries. At present there are 25 people getting benefits through MED loan. The defaulters of MED Loan beneficiaries insisted to repay the amount as early as possible.

Every effort is taken to enhance the life style of the remote Rural Dweller. Medical Camps are held where there are no medical facilities; quality Medical attention is offered at the Medical Camps.

Dear friends, I'd like to share my happiness with all that one of our inmates Mrs. Esther's daughter Ms. Sylvia is getting married soon...

Miss. Sylvia and Mrs. Esther hailing from Tirunelveli (72) lost the sole bread winner (Miss Rose Mary) of their family, in 2015, due to insufficient funds for medical treatment. The family's fortunes were squandered by an alcoholic father. The family had earlier lost 3 other children within a span of days. Due to extreme poverty Miss. Sylvia couldn't pursue education beyond 8th grade. She and her mother Mrs. Esther was also affected psychologically as they were unable to bear the continuous loss of loved ones and was undergoing treatment at our Hospital. Since the death of Miss Rosemary the family has been under our care (Peace Trust). Through God's grace Sylvia is recovering from her psychiatric illness and is expected to marry Pastor David soon.

Pas. David has done Master in Divinity. God has blessed him with wisdom and he is a blessing to many who can preach His word well. Any form of financial assistance could help return some form of normalcy to their lives.

CARE AND SUPPORT PROJECT

The Project activities and programmes of HIV communities care, Adolescent health care and education was supported by Malteser International through Pro-vision. These activities were implemented through Peace Trust at Various Blocks of Palayamkottai, Tirunelveli Corporation, Kuruvikulam, Sankarankoil and Vasudevanallur of Tirunelveli Districts. 37 adolescents received the higher education support during the project period. The adolescents are continuing their higher education is one of the successful in this project.

This Project has been implemented through our Peace Trust for the last 10 years successfully comes to an end on 30.09.2019. The valediction function was held at Peace

Trust office on the last day of the project. Dr. Johnson Raj, Chief Executive of pro-vision conducted the program. The partner NGO Directors shared the previous years' experience about the difficulties in the HIV field. All the staff shared the experience in the meeting. Finally Dr. Johnson Raj wish all the staff and gave gift to them as a token of gratitude.



TANSACS CORE GROUP PROJECT

The APAC – VHS – USAID sponsored STI, HIV/ AIDS Prevention project among Core Groups has completed three years of Yeomen service to the targeted community of Female Sex Workers and Men Having Sex with Men. Now the project had transitioned to the TANSACS for the next 1 year. (April'19 to March'20)

- ⇒ Number of HRG's tested in the ICTC Clinics MSM – 76 and FSW – 76 (Total : 193)

⇒ Our on-going HRG is FSW : 656 and MSM : 717 (Total :1373)

⇒ Identified New HRG : FSW-9,MSM-12 (Total-21)

⇒ CBS tested- 75
