Children Camp:

We conducted the Children Camp on 2nd October 2019 at Madhapuram Check post. The theme of this camp was "God with us". We taught the action songs, story telling, puppet show, magic show and film show. The children enjoyed very well. In this camp, more than 200 children participated eagerly.



Moral Activity Class:



* On 5th October 2019, Bro. Richard conducted the moral activity class demonstrating "Who is the real hero?" by games and action song. Birthday was celebrated for the children who celebrate their birthday during that week. 11 boys and 24 girls, totally 35 children were participated.

- * On 12th October 2019, the class started with the games. In this, 15 boys and 27 girls, totally 42 children eagerly participated in the game time and question time also.
- * On 19th October 2019, the class started with the game

time. In this activity, 21 boys and 46 girls, totally 67 children participated.

Monthly Special Meeting:

- * On 12th October 2019, we organized the monthly special meeting, the topic about "God gives a good life for every person" shared by Pas. Yesudasan. In this meeting, 3 fathers, 27 mothers and 14 children, total participants 44.

Chain Prayer:

We conducted the Chain Prayer on 26th October 2019, in that 19 church believers, 15 mothers, 3 fathers and 5 children, totally 42 participated and prayed individual for their needs.

Monthly meeting for Senior Children:

We organized the monthly meeting for the senior children on 28th October 2019. Mr. David Johnson conducted the meeting .



LINKS PEACE-MED

Program is functioning well with 202 beneficiaries being provided with Fund assistance to start viable ventures. The repayment of the beneficiaries is very encouraging making us to give advance to more beneficiaries. At present there are 28 people getting benefits through MED loan. The defaulters of MED Loan beneficiaries insisted to repay the amount as early as possible.

MEDICAL CAMP

Every effort is taken to enhance the life style of the remote Rural Dweller. Medical Camps are held where there are no medical facilities available. Quality Medical attention is offered at the Medical Camps.

PRIYAM & NESAM PROJECT

The girls who are studying from 5th to 12th grade, comes under Priyam Nesam girls program. All the 10th and 12th grade children are given special coaching from the beginning itself. Higher education is also provided to children both boys and girls, who have completed 12th grade comes under Nesam Higher study program.

The main objective of this program is to provide better education to the orphan and semi orphan children.

◇ In Priyam girls program, total beneficiaries – 25 girls (Velankulli – 15 girls and Kalakkadu -10 girls).

◇ In Nesam Higher study Program, total beneficiaries – 17 students (Vellankuli – 9 students and Kalakkadu – 8 students).

Activities:

⇒ Our Program In-charge met the Priyam girls and Nesam Higher studies program students and their

mothers in Kallakadu and Vellankuli every month.

⇒ Monthly nutrition support will be given during the children and parents meeting.

⇒ The staff in charge will meet the teachers and Principals periodically to know the children performance.

⇒ Advice will be given on Health, education, moral and Hygiene.

⇒ Personal counselling will be given to the children who approached us, after the meeting is over.



TANSACS CORE GROUP PROJECT



The APAC – VHS – USAID sponsored STI, HIV/ AIDS Prevention project among Core Groups has completed three years of Yeomen service to the targeted community of Female

Sex Workers and Men Having Sex with Men. Now the project had transitioned to the TANSACS for the next 1 year. (April'19 to March'20).

⇒ Number of HRG's tested in the STI Clinics MSM -91 , FSW – 87 and PT- 17 (Total :195)

⇒ Number of HRG's tested in the ICTC Clinics MSM –72 and FSW – 69 (Total : 141)

⇒ Our ongoing HRG is FSW : 663 and MSM : 719 (Total :1382)

⇒ Identified New HRG : FSW-7,MSM-4 (Total-11)

“ARARAT” PEACE RESTORATION HOME

One of our Aarath Home inmates Ms. Sylvia got married on Oct 25th, 2019.

Miss. Sylvia and Mrs. Esther hailing from Tirunelveli (72) lost the sole breadwinner (Miss Rose Mary) of their family in 2015, due to insufficient funds for medical treatment. The family's fortunes were squandered by an alcoholic father. The family had earlier lost 3 other children within a span of days. Due to extreme poverty Miss. Sylvia couldn't pursue education beyond 8th grade. She and her mother Mrs. Esther was also affected psychologically as they were unable to bear the continuous loss of loved ones and was undergoing treatment at our hospital. Since the death of Miss Rosemary, the family has been under our care (Peace Trust). Through God's grace Sylvia has recovered from her psychiatric illness and married Pastor David on Oct 25th, 2019.

Pas. David has done a Master's in Divinity. God has blessed him with wisdom and he is a blessing to many who can preach His word well. After marriage, he wants to live in a separate home as his father is an alcoholic and also his parents were Hindus. He doesn't want his marital life to be

affected and he is afraid this may create a negative impact on Sylvia as she is recovering from her psychological problem.

Any form of financial assistance could help return some form of normalcy to their lives. Kindly uphold them in your daily prayers.
