We helped all Peace Trust staff working in the projects

and also the project beneficiaries by giving provisions to them. We also provided provisions to TGS, PLHIVs, HRGs, and PEs who suffered a lot. Ten thousand cooked food packs were given to poor people, and Migrant workers. Fifty food packs were provided to Blind people who are residing on the road side everyday. We were able to do this only because of our sponsors and well-wishers. Masks were also given to them and gave orientation about COVID.

Also, Our staff helped the PLHIVs who were not able to travel due to lockdown, to get the ART drugs from the ART centre, and delivered at their door steps.

I am grateful to you all for your support and prayers. May our Lord bless you and your families!

Home Visits & Supports

- ◆ During the lockdown period, we did home visits on the needed basis. First, we scrutinized the needs of the beneficiaries and their families and then took efforts to fulfill the needs of the beneficiaries and their families:
- ◆ We bought the medicines and gave to the beneficiaries who are taking regular medicines for their illness. In that way, we gave to three special children, one diabetic grandmother and one boy with heart disease. Also, we admitted one child's father in the hospital, who was having seizures and also mentally stressed, and gave proper treatment. Now he is doing well and goes to work.
- ◆ Ms. Malar & Ms. Elangavathy, our staff visited the children, at their homes, who are average in their studies and motivated them to attend the slow learners' class regularly.
- ◆ Also visits the special children at their homes to find out their needs and fulfill it.
- ◆ Mr. Reuban visited the senior children houses and encouraged them to attend the grammar class which is conducted daily in the evening at our Rhema Centre.

Special Tuition:

⇒ Due to the lockdown from 26th March 2020 onwards, we are not able to gather more children.



In this situation, we made arrangements and split the children into two groups. One group under the slow learners, attended the tuition and

coaching was given to them. And the remaining children will be at home studying and conducted exam by giving them a model question paper. In the first group four children attended and in the second group, five children wrote the exam in their home.

Tuition Class for Senior Children:

During the month of May 2020, Mr. Reuban conducted the evening tuition class every day and students from 10th Standard, 11th Standard and Nursing College, attended regularly. The children were preparing for their Public Exam and the Nursing students for their Semester Exam. Nearly 20 children attended.

Tuition Class for Slow Learners:

On 18th May 2020 onwards, Ms. Malar & Ms. Elangavathy regularly conducted the evening tuition class for slow

learners. Now-a-days up to 25 children are eagerly participating every day.

Evening Tuition Class

- ◆ Mr. Reuban conducts the grammar class and competitive coaching class for the senior children.
- ◆ Ms. Elangavathy conducts the evening tuition class for slow learners, regularly.
- ◆ Ms. Malar conducts the evening tuition class for 12th STD children daily.



Discipline, Health & Hygienic Class

We organized a workshop for the children from 8th June 2020 to 12th June 2020 regarding the Discipline, Health & Hygiene. We divided in 10 clusters and conducted the classes in 2



batches. Nearly 220 children eagerly participated in this class. We distributed the prizes for the regular attendance and Mask were given to all the children.

COVID-19 Awareness Meeting

On 26th June 2020, we conducted the COVID-19 awareness meeting and explained about the COVID guidelines to be followed through a simple word "SMS", 'S' for Soap (sanitation), 'M' for Mask and 'S' for Social Distance. 43 children participated, and they easily understood and are following the SMS practices in their day-to-day life.



COVID'19 Help to the Beneficiaries and also the Church believers:

On 28th April 2020, our Peace Trust distributed rice and provisions to the church believers and project beneficiaries in Vellanguli. In this regard, our old staff in RHEMA project, well-wishers and philanthropist supported this good cause. **Dr. R. Anburajan**, Director of Peace



Trust took hard efforts for fulfill the needs of the beneficiaries and their families during this difficult time.

COVID'19 Help to the Project staff and Beneficiaries

During the month of May 2020, our Peace Trust Director, **Dr. R. Anburajan** provided the Rice and Groceries to the Project beneficiaries and also the project staff. This help fulfilled the needs of the staff, beneficiaries and their families. The staff shared the heartfelt thanks to him for this help.

Links Peace - MED

Program is functioning well with 216 beneficiaries being provided with Fund assistance to start viable ventures from April, 2020 to July, 2020. The repayment of the beneficiaries is very encouraging making us to give advance to more beneficiaries. At present there are 31 people getting benefits through MED loan. The defaulters of MED Loan beneficiaries are insisted to repay the amount as early as possible.

We bought a new bicycle and it's very helpful for the nurse to come on time for her duty and also to go for a small purchases. Our nurse Mrs. Julie celebrated her son's first birthday with us on 13th

April.

Our inmate, Mrs. Gnanaseeli's birthday was celebrated

with cake cutting on 2nd July and had a special lunch on that day.

One of our inmates, Mrs. Dhanarathnam's health was improved and her family took her back home.

Even though we are in the lockdown period our staffs are working hard to take care of our inmates. Our director Dr. R. Anburajan gifted a bundle of provisions to all the staff who are working in Ararat Home. Face Mask, Sanitizer and preventive medicines for Corona, were also distributed to all the staff in the home.

All the staffs are very thankful to Dr.R. Anburajan.

We are conducting the prayer in the morning and evening regularly.

April –We organized the monthly meeting for the Priyam Girls &Nesam Higher Study Programs children and their parents on 24th April 2020. The program in-charge, Mr. Johnson gave the awareness about the COVID-19 and also motivated the higher study students to participate in the online classes and to prepare well for semester exams. Due to lockdown many parents were unemployed as most of them are working as a daily wagers and hence they suffered a lot. Therefore, during the meeting we distributed 10Kg rice and provisions for 15 days. 24 beneficiaries from Vellankuli and 18 from Kalakaddu. Total 42 beneficiaries were benefitted.

May - Priyam & Nesam programe was conducted at Chidambarapuram and Vellankuli. In Chidambarapuram village one positive case was found and then was referred to the Government hospital. In the lock time period, one of our

Priyam child mother got temporary post at Panchayat Office for covid 19 preventive measures related work. Our programe beneficiaries are doing well by His grace during this period.

June - We communicated with our beneficiaries over the phone on 18.06.2020 & 29.06.2020 to know about the situations prevailing in their villages and families. Also conducted the meeting at Panchayat building for the **Chidambarapuram Priyam & Nesam** students and shared the covid 19 preventive measures to be taken.

July - We conducted the meeting for **Priyam & Nesam beneficiaries** who are residing at **Chidambarapuram** on 30.07.2020 at the Panchayat building. We distributed the Rice and Groceries to Priyam Girls and Nesam students belongs to kalakkadu area. For those who could not come in person to collect the groceries, we delivered at their home. We also distributed the Rice and groceries for the Priyam & Nesam beneficiaries at Vellankuli.

The students are attending the classes through virtual.

This program is supported by MAHENDRAN, Germany. All the students and their parents conveyed their gratitude to their sponsors Mrs. Astrid, Dr. Walter, and their team.

TANSACS CORE GROUP PROJECT

Important Activity:

1.COVID-19 Support to our project HRGs:

During the lockdown, PLHIVs, HRGs, PEs, and Staff finds difficulty to run their day to day life and faced a problem of their daily livelihood. Considering this fact, Peace Trust



distributed Rice, Groceries, and two masks to them at their door steps and they were happy to receive it. They thanked our Director. We have distributed in the Districts of Tirunelveli and Tenkasi.



2. COVID19 Supported to TGs

As TGs were also suffered during this time, we got some support through well wishers from Sankarankoil and provided rice and groceries to 43 TGS. It had been distributed to TGs in Alangulam and Tenkasi. The social welfare Department also gave the support to the 12 TGS, who are registered as a member in the Social Welfare Department.

PROGRAM FOR YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

We wanted the youths to utilize this lock down period in a useful way. So we decided to give them Gym equipment to do exercise. We discussed with them, and make them to select a common



place where everyone can come. The youths followed our instructions and formed the club. We selected the leaders and requested them to follow the COVID guidelines.

On 8th May 2020, we distributed the exercise equipments and gave the awareness about the COVID-19 and also what are the procedures should be followed in the regular day to day exercise. All the youths are happily working out every day. We do hope this health activity may change the youths from bad habits like smoking and drinking.



TANSACS TI-MIGRANT PROJECT

Dry Ration distributed for PLHIV.

As COVID – 19 continues to threaten the livelihoods of thousands, Peace Trust is responding amidst this challenge in reaching out to the needs of the most children Vulnerable



and families affected by the pandemic, by providing dry rations during the nationwide lockdown.

In selected communities we work with, we reached out

to children with messages on COVID-19 awareness, hygiene practices and child protection. Our project team have been in touch with children, Poor, and Migrants who are affected with PLHIV. We are also in touch with TGs and others through mobile calls from their field itself, to ensure their well being and Safety.

Total PIHIV got Support – 7 Nos.

ART Medicine Distributed:

Due to Lockdown and no transportation PLHIV can't able to travel to ART Centre. So in this situation, We brought ART medicine from Tirunelveli ART Centre and gave to them at their door step.

We'd like to convey our regards and thanks to our Director, Dr R. Anburajan for the timely help towards the needy and those who are in trouble.
